

WELCOME to the second edition of the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation Annual Report. I want to begin this report by thanking all of you, our donors, for supporting the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation.

Your support has led to meaningful results that have impacted our undergraduates by the Foundation providing more than \$52,000 in educational grants to the Fraternity, and awarded record scholarships of more than \$100,000 to our undergraduate Brothers. In addition we have strengthened countless relationships with our Brothers.

I am very pleased with our performance and to have played a role in these accomplishments. The Foundation and our Fraternity are stronger today and our flame is shining brighter, thanks to you and your generous support.

Kappa Delta Rho has always been a good, small Fraternity that strives to create KDR Gentlemen who place honor before all things. We consistently have between 30-40 active chapters and we consistently rate as one of the premier "smaller Fraternities", according to the North-American Interfraternity Conference (NIC). We are proud of those accomplishments. But we want more. We are challenging ourselves to RAISE THE BAR.

Thirty years ago, the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation was relaunched with the express goal of providing support for educational programming and scholarships to members of the National Fraternity of Kappa Delta Rho. Over those thirty years the Foundation has worked hard, as it completed two capital campaigns with 622 donors contribution more than two million dollars in educational grants to the Fraternity. During those three decades we also awarded more than a million dollars in scholarships directly to our Brothers. Now we want to do more!

We live in a challenging time and our Brothers are graduating into an unsettled world. We want to do more to assist them. We want to

The Foundation is proud of the support that we provide, but we want to do more. Since the National Fraternity started the Consuls Academy in 2009, the average size of our chapters has nearly doubled and our average GPA has increased. Now the National Fraternity has developed and is launching an ambitious new program called The Legion. We think this program has the potential to greatly enhance the skills that we provide to all of our undergraduates. We want to help support it. We want to challenge the National Fraternity to fully roll out the program and RAISE THEIR BAR.

We want to help provide the funding for Kappa Delta Rho to thrive in the future. We want to grow beyond 50 chapters, we want to be leaders on our campuses, we want to produce quality new Brothers who live up to our motto of *Honor Su per Omnia*. We are challenging ourselves to RAISE THE BAR and we are asking you to join us.

We feel it is important that we report to you the impact of your generous donations towards our mission of supporting the educational endeavors of the National Fraternity of Kappa Delta Rho. Each year we provide direct educational support and award more than 100 scholarships to our Brothers. It is also equally important that we are transparent in our operations to ensure you that we are good stewards of your donations and the assets of the Foundation. To this end, we are publishing our second edition of our annual report for you, our donors.

FROM THE PRESIDENT

During the fiscal year of 2015-2016 the Foundation received in \$144,201.85 in donations. David Clark, Vice President of the Annual Fund, will provide a full report of donations received and the impact of your generous support. Every August Pennington & Company publishes a report on 52 National Foundations that support 52 National Fraternities, assessing how each fare among its peers. We are a fairly young foundation compared to our peers, as we were founded in 1986. However, I am very pleased to write you that we are doing exceptionally well. What is more important is how well we are doing with manag-

Looking forward to our next 30 years, we ask that you please continue to support the Foundation as we seek to meet Kappa Delta Rho's educational and scholarship needs

ing the donations and directing the funds to support our undergraduates. In the area of philanthropic endeavors when evaluating a charity it is important to look at the financial health of the organization. There are two metrics that provide a snapshot of the financial health of 501(c)3 Foundations, which are Fundraising Efficiency Ratio and Program Services Ratio. Fundraising Efficiency Ratio is obtained by dividing fundraising expenses by annual support. According to BBB Wise Giving Alliance (www.give.org) and Charity Watch (www.charitywatch.org) Foundations should be spending 35 cents or lower for every dollar they are fundraising which would be considered. We are proud to say the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation Fundraising

Efficiency Ratio is 15%, which means we are only spending \$0.15 on every dollar that is raised. The average cost for a Fraternal Foundation to raise a dollar was \$0.22 last year. So our efforts in being good stewards is exceeding the industry average for fraternal foundations. This is critical because \$0.85 of every dollar you donate is directly impacting the educational endeavors of the National Fraternity through grants or one of our many scholarships to our Brothers to support their education. Program Services Ratio is obtained by dividing program expenses by total expenses. According to BBB Wise Giving Alliance (www. give.org) and Charity Watch (www.charitywatch.org) Foundations should have 65% or more of total expenses spent on programs like our Consuls Academy, Elmon M. Williams Leadership Academy or our scholarships. The Kappa Delta Rho Foundation's Program Services Ratio is 78% which is much better than the average (52%) Program Services Ratio for fraternal foundations.

In addition to a report on the giving you will find in this issue a report on the scholarships provided to our Brothers, a report on our performance regarding the Foundation's investments, an overall report on our budget, and an update on the educational programs your donations are supporting. ANNUAL FUND 2015-16 EXCEEDS GOAL

Annual Fund donors continue to make a difference in the lives of Brothers

THE 2015-16 ANNUAL FUND fiscal year (FY) was a remarkable success. The generosity of all our donors enabled the Foundation to provide \$52,494 in educational grants to the National Fraternity to support educational programming, which enriches the KDR experience. These grants, in addition to working collaboratively with the Fraternity to share staff, have had a direct impact on undergraduates by providing revenue that resulted in savings of \$155 for each Brother. Furthermore, the Foundation was able to award 221 scholarships to Brothers this past fiscal year totaling \$115,200.

FINANCIAL OVERVIEW

The generosity of our Brothers helped the Foundation exceed its goal of \$142,860. In fact, the final total was \$144,201.85, which represented the largest amount of Annual Fund donations received by the Foundation in the last 18 years. During the 2015-16 FY, the Foundation received \$16,417 more in Annual Fund donations — an amazing 13 percent increase from the 2014-15 FY. Moreover, donations have increased for six consecutive years. In fact, Annual Fund support has risen consistently, not only in the amount raised, but in the number of Brothers donating to the Foundation. This extraordinary level of commitment was accomplished by 570 donors!

The Annual Fund offers donors the opportunity to impact the lives of more than 1,600 undergraduates by contributing through several unrestricted funds established within the Foundation, including the Parents Fund, the Matching Gift Fund, and the Order of Peregrine Falcon Fund.

Parents of our undergraduate Brothers, such as Bruce and Susan Timok, deserve our gratitude. Bruce, who is a founding father of the Omega Alpha Chapter at Virginia Commonwealth University, and his wife have two sons who are Brothers at the Tau Alpha Chapter at Radford University. They donated to the Parents Fund to support educational programs that have had a positive impact on their sons' overall KDR experience. 2015-16 Fiscal Year, 64 parents donated \$5,440 to the Annual Fund, and that kind of support from undergraduate parents continues to grow.

One significant way donors can increase their Annual Fund contributions is to check to see if their company or institution participates in a matching gift program. Mark Nowakowski, lota Beta '92, is one Brother who participates in the Matching Gift Fund by donating through the Soros Fund Charitable Foundation. Another Brother who participates in the Matching Gift Fund is Barrett Amos, Beta '08, who participates through Microsoft's annual Employee Giving Campaign, which matches dollar for dollar the donation that Barrett directs to the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation. Thanks to Brothers like Mark and Barrett, the Foundation received \$7,060 in additional funds not only from companies such as the Soros Fund Charitable Foundation and Microsoft's annual Employee Giving Campaign, but from Apple, the Fidelity Charitable Gift Fund, the GE Foundation, and the Lilly Endowment, to name a few that match their employees' philanthropic efforts.

Annual Fund donors continue to make a significant investment in the lives of undergraduate Brothers. Their financial commitment is a testament to making a difference by helping to build a pattern for success!



THIS YEAR AT THE 2016 National Convention of Kappa Delta Rho, held in St. Louis, Missouri, over \$72,000 worth of scholarships were awarded to Brothers of Kappa Delta Rho for their achievements in academics and service to the Fraternity. One Brother in particular was awarded the largest amount in scholarships ever awarded to a single student in KDR Foundation's history. Will McElhaney, currently an undergraduate Brother of the Nu chapter at Indiana University, was the recipient of more than \$6,000 in various scholarships from the Foundation. Majoring in Economic Consulting with the Kelley School of Business, Will is also part of the honors program at Indiana University. Will joined KDR in November of 2014 during his freshman year due to his belief that the Brothers of Kappa Delta Rho were a more respectful group of men whose values aligned best with his own.

During his time in Kappa Delta Rho, Will has made outstanding achievements within Kappa Delta Rho and Student Life at IU. In the spring of 2015, Will was elected to serve as treasurer, where he worked with collecting member dues and overseeing the chapter's budget. During this time, Will exhibited extraordinary leadership abilities in Kappa Delta Rho and was subsequently elected to serve as the Consul of the Nu chapter the following year. Will was able to engage directly with constituents and attend policy briefings to gain firsthand experience in the inner workings of the United States Senate

Will plans to graduate from IU and attend Harvard Law, where he can study anti-discrimination law or sex crime persecution, a perfect match for his passion for helping others. Will hopes that with one of those areas of law he can work for the ACLU or a similar organization to bring about change that can make a difference.

Will McElhaney was the perfect candidate to win the awards given to him at Convention. Since his time in Kappa Delta Rho he has grown to be an amazing leader that has grown and motivated his chapter to continue to strive to be the best. 
The Kappa Delta Rho Foundation provides a vital support function in the growth and success of Kappa Delta Rho by providing financial resources to keep our fraternity relevant, strong and growing. With the support of our alumni and friends, more than \$363,044 has been granted to the Fraternity for educational and leadership programming since 2012. In addition, \$490,950 in chapter specific or field of study specific scholarships has been awarded to Kappa Delta Rho undergraduates and alumni during this time.

The Foundation fully supports the creation and endowment of new scholarships and has established policies governing restricted purpose and endowment funds consistent with applicable law. We account for these assets in separate funds based on fund purpose and donor-imposed restrictions. The Foundation seeks to preserve the corpus and utilize only earnings for all endowment funds with a current maximum payout rate of 5% (as defined in its Investment Policy Statement – revised 2011). An endowment fund is formed only upon the creation and acceptance by the Foundation of an Endowment Fund Agreement that conforms to relevant policy. In recent years, several scholarships have become fully endowed including the Richard J. Petronis Zeta Beta Scholarship Fund, the Paul Downes lota Beta Scholarship Fund and the Robert D. Lynd Scholarship Fund.




SCHOLARSHIPS DISTRIBUTED 2012-2016



An additional avenue of service provided by the Foundation is providing short-term loans to chapters in need through the Chapter loan fund.

The Foundation's asset allocation places priority on preserving endowment corpus by conservatively investing in a mix of equity and debt index funds to produce investment returns at a rate exceeding inflation. The Investment Committee of the Foundation is responsible for the management of all endowed funds of the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation. These funds include the general endowment, which supports the educational programming of the Fraternity, as well as the numerous scholarships designated to support the ongoing education of our active members and alumni pursuing undergraduate and graduate degrees.







young men who follow us by making a commitment to the KDR Foundation. Consequently, my estate plan calls for a seven-figure planned gift to the Foundation when I pass into Chapter Eternal. That's my investment in the future, but above all, it's my personal commitment to a set of core fraternal values and ideals that are more important today than ever before.

What's your next step? When you have made the important decision to create a will or trust or revise an existing one, or designate the Foundation as beneficiary of a life insurance policy, I recommend you work with your attorney or financial advisor. There are several options to consider. For example, you may restrict your planned gift to a specific program endowment or you may want to set up an endowed scholarship fund for your chapter or you can stipulate a particular area of academic study. I would be happy to talk to you about ways you can impact the lives of young men in your chapter or within KDR, in general.
