

WE ARE PROUD TO PRESENT YOU with the 2019-20 edition of the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation Annual Report. This is my first Annual Report as Foundation President, so let me initially thank our past President, Gregg Klein, OA '95, for his guidance and leadership. Thankfully, he is remaining a Trustee and will be an active participant in Foundation endeavors. I have served as a volunteer for Kappa Delta Rho for nearly thirty years, as a member of the National Board of Directors for ten years holding several officer positions, and the Foundation Board for the past eighteen years, serving as the Vice President - Investment since 2005. I am honored and privileged to be succeeding Brother Klein as Kappa Delta Rho Foundation President. This past year was a difficult one for the Foundation in that contributions to the Annual Fund declined versus the prior year. The impact that COVID-19 has had on our Brotherhood cannot be understated. There are many Brothers who have lost jobs, or seen compensation reduced as firms look to cut costs and navigate through a weakened economy. Universities closed their doors and sent students home in the spring and transitioned to remote learning. There is still much uncertainty as to how this academic year will evolve.

However, we can all be proud of the resilience our undergraduate Brothers displayed while navigating these uncertain times. Because of your support, the National developed an online educational program that could be utilized seamlessly throughout the spring semester. In addition, our educational program recently won the Laurel Wreath Award from the North American Interfraternity Conference. A quote from the press release: "This pioneering curriculum is at the forefront of industry trends in organizational development." Throughout the spring, our chapters continued to operate, and our new members that were recruited this past semester were initiated as planned. The ability for our Fraternity to continue to stand head and shoulders above our peers is a direct result of the financial support that you, the Brothers and benefactors of Kappa Delta Rho, have generously donated to the Foundation. Thank you!

While awards are somewhat satisfying, the Fraternity is not resting on these laurels. There is much more that we can do to improve and enhance the fraternity experience for our Brotherhood. KDR is developing new, cutting edge programming to enhance the health and wellness of our undergraduate Brothers, Brothers' Keeper. Providing the programming is in line with our Precepts where we promise to "engage in the service of mankind, not for the praise or recognition that such service may bring, but because it is

IT HAS PROVEN TO BE A CHALLENGING TIME for many organizations, with COVID-19 and the resulting economic recession. Kappa Delta Rho is not immune. With that said, the Foundation's results were impressive. Three hundred seventy-six (376) of you provided support of just over \$121,000 for the Annual Fund. Your support enabled us to impact the lives of our undergraduate Brothers through awarding more than \$100,000 in scholarships (40 Brothers from 14 chapters) and another 40 plus Brothers attending Consuls Academy in January 2020.

Since March 2020, KDR has risen to the challenge and overcome many obstacles placed in our way, so that our Order can thrive and grow in these uncertain times. KDR continues to provide services to our undergraduate members, as their host colleges and universities work out what normal operations should look like during this challenging period. Some of the services KDR provides include:

- Providing a virtual environment for the chapters to facilitate meetings and events to maintain contact with their chapter Brothers.
- Facilitating coaching calls for chapters on how to operate in this new environment, so when we return to normalcy, our

chapters hit the ground running.

- Offering access to a Mental Health awareness and education platform, Kappa Delta Rho Lifelines, to provide information to our Brothers (Alumni and Undergraduate) to successfully manage and cope with the new normal (http:kappadeltarho.ulifeline.org/).
- Training and coaching on how to facilitate virtual recruitment to ensure our chapters maintain their membership.

This past Fiscal Year (FY), as a Brotherhood, we recorded our 13th highest Annual Fund giving in our 25-year history, which demonstrates the continued commitment of our alumni, undergraduates, parents, and friends of the fraternity. We continue to strive to be good stewards of your generosity. The Foundation's five-year average for its Fundraising Efficiency is 15% which means we are only spending \$.15 for every dollar raised. What is more incredible is our five-year average for Program Services Ratio is 72% which means \$.72 of every dollar donated is directly going to support our mission of providing educational and scholarship opportunities to our Fraternity. We are only spending \$.13 of every dollar raised to operate the Foundation.








THE KAPPA DELTA RHO FOUNDATION provides a vital support function in the growth and success of Kappa Delta Rho by providing financial resources to keep our fraternity strong and growing. With the support of our alumni and friends, more than \$363,578 has been granted to the Fraternity for educational and leadership programming since 2014. In addition, \$732,698 in chapter specific or field of study specific scholarships has been awarded to Kappa Delta Rho undergraduates and alumni during this time.

ASSETS UNDER MANAGEMENT (as of June 30)



The Foundation's asset allocation places priority on preserving endowment corpus by conservatively investing in a mix of equity and debt index funds to produce investment returns at a rate exceeding inflation. The Investment Committee of the Foundation is responsible for the management of all endowed funds of the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation. These funds include the general endowment, which supports the educational programming of the Fraternity, as well as the numerous scholar-ships designated to support the ongoing education of our active members and alumni pursuing undergraduate and graduate degrees.



The Foundation fully supports the creation and endowment of new scholarships and has established policies governing restricted purpose and endowment funds consistent with applicable law. We account for these assets in separate funds based on fund purpose and donor-imposed restrictions. The Foundation seeks to preserve the corpus and utilize only earnings for all endowment funds with a current maximum payout rate of 5% (as defined in its Investment

Policy Statement – revised 2011). An endowment fund is formed only upon the creation and acceptance by the Foundation of an Endowment Fund Agreement that conforms to relevant policy. In recent years, several scholarships have become fully endowed including the Paul Downes lota Beta Scholarship Fund, the Robert D. Lynd Scholarship Fund and the lota Beta Chapter Scholarship Fund.

An additional avenue of service the Foundation provides is offering the Chapter Loan Fund. The Fund was established by the Trustees to make loans as an aid to chapters or alumni corporations of the Fraternity in building, remodeling, purchasing, financing or refinancing chapter houses or for acquiring equipment, furnishings, or fixtures for the chapter. The Fund acts as a revolving fund and all loan payments, including interest are retained within the Fund and recycled for future chapter loans.



It began when the staff and leadership identified that KDR had experienced an average of one suicide per year over the last ten years. This was not only tragic but led to in depth discussions. We knew it was a societal issue, but the question arose should we, as a fraternal family, within reason have programs to "have our Brother's back"? We are proud to say the conclusion was yes! We are even prouder to share that KDR is implementing an industry leading program called Brothers' Keeper that is intended to provide resources and opportunities to support and educate our undergraduate Brothers.

The Brothers' Keeper Campaign has a goal to raise \$2.5 million over the next five years to provide endowed resources to support the programs in perpetuity. We each know that over time the needs may evolve or change, but they will never go

THE PROGRAM IS INTENDED TO PROVIDE:

- Lifeline: KDR, in collaboration with the JED Foundation, developed online resources on mental-health concerns through a KDR-branded website, kappadeltarho.ulifeline.org.
- Access available online to a talk therapist (24 hours a day) for those at risk or their peers.
- Legion Member Education Program: An award-winning total member education that utilizes blended learning and is self-directed after the initial period of membership.
- TIPS Training: **T**raining for **I**ntervention **P**rocedure**S** is educational programming and training for the responsible service, sale, and consumption of alcohol.
- Educational programming at the Consuls Academy and Elmon M. Williams Leadership Academy: These programs are to educate the undergraduates on the current mental-health issues and effective leadership skills, as well as the resources available to support them.
- Mental Health First Aid (www.mentalhealthfirstaid.com): Mental Health First Aid teaches you how to identify, to understand, and to respond to signs of mental illness and substance use disorders in your community.
- Director of Health & Wellness position. An endowed position of director of health and wellness, whose responsibility it is to oversee the implementation of the Brothers' Keeper program and risk-management education.



Highlights from last FY include:

Total giving decreased slightly by 8.5% over the previous FY. We raised just over \$314,000 between the Annual Fund, Restricted Giving, and Scholarships.

In the area of Restricted Giving (gifts other than the Annual Fund), we raised over \$139,000 with the majority going to Brothers' Keeper (a new initiative of ongoing support for the Brotherhood, which includes educational, leadership, character development programs, and mental health resources).

Scholarship program had another great year with gifts coming in just over \$53,000, which was up 5.3% from the previous year.

You are genuinely impassioned about KDR, and it shows through the contributions you have made this past FY, whether donating your time, your talent, your financial support, or all three.

I want to thank all of you who have helped this past year in our journey to strengthening KDR's Foundation and ask for your continued support moving forward.


