



e are proud to present you with the 2020-21 edition of the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation Annual Report. After completing my first full year as President of the Foundation, I am excited to share with you

some of the successes and challenges that we have faced, and how we intend to build off of them to create a stronger Foundation and Fraternity. As a Foundation we are "ALL IN!" as we have rededicated ourselves to the work necessary to make our Fraternity stronger by raising the financial resources required to provide the services that our undergraduate members deserve.

This fiscal year was a year of uncertainty for many of our alumni and undergraduate Brothers as we became more accustomed to talking to a camera or a computer screen than having face-to-face interactions. While this way of communicating was awkward for some, it also allowed Brothers to reconnect in ways they may not have otherwise. Alumni gathered for Zoom Happy Hours and other online events to stay connected to their Brothers. The Foundation utilized this opportunity to invite more volunteers to join our midyear strategy sessions than we could have for an in-person meeting. We continue to receive positive feedback as more Brothers get involved with Foundation activities. We will explore other opportunities through the year to expand our outreach to Alumni Brothers and friends of KDR; the backbone of our Fraternity.

Allow me to list some of the accomplishments this past fiscal year:

NEW SCHOLARSHIPS – We approved four new scholarships/building funds, including our first needs based scholarship – maybe the most funds established in one year since the Foundation was formed. More alumni are stepping up to provide a lasting legacy for our membership!

CAPITAL CAMPAIGN PROGRESS - We are more than halfway (>\$1.3M) to our Brothers' Keeper capital campaign goal of \$2.5M to fund new programming tar-

geting mental health support and mental health first aid in our Brotherhood.

ANNUAL FUND UPTICK – We exceeded our fundraising goal for the Annual Fund for the first time in several years, although the number of Brothers donating declined. We expect to reverse that trend by providing more details of the positive outcomes your contributions have on the undergraduates.

This fiscal year was a year of uncertainty for many of our alumni and undergraduate Brothers.

BETTER COMMUNICATION – We have been more engaged with the Fraternity Board and our Alumni than we have been in several years. We understand the need to promote the positive impact derived from your support of the Fraternity's educational and wellness programming. Expect more encouraging stories in the coming year.

Donation dollars well spent. We can all be proud of how well the National Fraternity and our undergraduate Brothers navigated these uncertain times. Because of your support, the National Fraternity developed an online educational program that could be utilized seamlessly throughout the fall and spring semesters. While other fraternities struggled with the complexities of recruiting and educating during the pandemic, KDR's operations were as close to "business as usual" as it could be. The Fraternity's success is a direct result of the financial support that you, the Brothers and benefactors of Kappa Delta Rho, have generously donated to the Foundation. THANK YOU!

s we look back on another year with continued challenges, the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation has made progress in many areas, and I want to take a moment to say thank you.

Thanks to the commitment of donors like you, we beat our Annual Fund goal and ended the fiscal year just under \$124,000.

KDR has risen to the challenge and overcome many obstacles placed in our way, so our Fraternity can continue to thrive and grow in these uncertain times. We continue to provide services to our undergraduate members, as colleges and universities return to normal operations. Some of those services include:

- Delivering a virtual environment for chapters to facilitate meetings, recruitment, and events to maintain their membership.
- Facilitating coaching calls for chapters on how to operate in a semi-virtual environment.
- Offering access to a Mental Health awareness and education platform, Kappa Delta Rho Lifelines, to provide information to our Brothers (Alumni and Undergraduate) to successfully manage and cope with the new normal (http:kappadeltarho.ulifeline.org/).

For FY 2020- 2021, the continued dedication of our alumni, undergraduates, parents, and friends of the Fraternity have helped us achieve the following:

■ Total giving increased by 20.3% over the previous FY. We raised just over \$388,000 between the Annual Fund, Restricted Giving, and Scholarships.

In the area of Restricted Giving, we raised over \$225,000 with the majority coming in for the Brothers' Keeper Campaign at \$197,800. As a reminder, Brothers' Keeper is our new initiative of ongoing support for the Brotherhood which includes educational, leadership, and

character development programs, along with mental health resources. By August 2021, we were halfway (>\$1.3M) to our goal of \$2.5M as mentioned earlier by Foundation President, Hall Jones.

Scholarship donations saw another solid year coming in just under \$39,000. Congratulations goes out to both Rho (Lafayette College) and lota Beta (Rochester Institute of Technology) alumni for leading the way with 87% of the total Scholarship gifts received in FY 2020-2021.

From all of us at the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation, I want to say thank you as we're grateful for your continued support!


A Financial Overview of the **Kappa Delta Rho Foundation**





he Kappa Delta Rho Foundation provides a vital support function in the growth and success of Kappa Delta Rho by providing financial resources to keep our Fraternity strong and growing. With the support of our alumni and friends, more than \$310,173 has been granted to the Fraternity for educational and leadership programming since 2015. In addition, \$647,368 in scholarships have been awarded to Kappa Delta Rho undergraduates and alumni during this time.

ASSETS UNDER MANAGEMENT (as of June 30)



The Foundation's asset allocation places priority on preserving endowment corpus by conservatively investing in a mix of equity and debt index funds to produce investment returns at a rate exceeding inflation. The Investment Committee of the Foundation is responsible for the management of all endowed funds of the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation. These funds include the general endowment, which supports the educational programming of the Fraternity, as well as the numerous scholarships designated to support the ongoing education of our active members and alumni pursuing undergraduate and graduate degrees.



The Foundation fully supports the creation and endowment of new scholarships and has established policies governing restricted purpose and endowment funds consistent with applicable law. We account for these assets in separate funds based on fund purpose and donor-imposed restrictions. The Foundation seeks to preserve the corpus and utilize only earnings for all endowment funds with a current maximum payout rate of 5% (as defined in its Investment Policy Statement - revised 2011). An endowment fund is formed only upon the creation and acceptance by the Foundation of an Endowment Fund Agreement that conforms to relevant policy. In recent years, several scholarships have become fully endowed including the Paul Downes

lota Beta Scholarship Fund, the Robert D. Lynd Scholarship Fund and the lota Beta Chapter Scholarship Fund.

One additional service provided by the Foundation to the Chapters is offering short-term loans to Chapters in need through the Chapter Loan Fund. The Fund was established by the Trustees to make loans as an aid to Chapters or alumni corporations of the fraternity in building, remodeling, purchasing, financing or refinancing chapter houses or for acquiring equipment, furnishings, or fixtures for the chapter. The Fund acts as a revolving fund and all loan payments, including interest are retained within the Fund and recycled for future chapter loans.







Today, we have more than 17,500 living alumni of KDR; however, less than 10 percent make annual or special gifts to the Fraternity through the Foundation - a dismal showing at best! We should have 30-40 percent of our membership providing some amount of financial commitment to KDR so that its ideals and programs will be perpetuated into the future. KDR's should take a look sometime to see what other fraternities are doing in the area of gifting and it may well open some eyes and hearts as to what should be happening. It makes no difference as to the amount of the gift - some can always give more than others. More importantly, however, it is

- Lifeline: KDR, in collaboration with the JED Foundation, developed online resources on mental-health concerns through a KDR-branded website, kappadeltarho.ulifeline.org.
- Access available online to a talk therapist (24 hours a day) for those at risk or their peers.
- Legion Member Education Program: An award-winning total member education that utilizes blended learning and is self-directed after the initial period of membership.
- TIPS Training: Training for Intervention ProcedureS is educational programming and training for the responsible service, sale, and consumption of alcohol.
- Educational programming at the Consuls Academy and Elmon M. Williams Leadership Academy: These programs are to educate the undergraduates on the current mental-health issues and effective leadership skills, as well as the resources available to support them.
- Mental Health First Aid (www.mentalhealthfirstaid.com): Mental Health First Aid teaches you how to identify, to understand, and to respond to signs of mental illness and substance use disorders in your community.
- Director of Health & Wellness position. An endowed position of Director of Health and Wellness, whose responsibility it is to oversee the implementation of the Brothers' Keeper program and risk-management education.


