



## **A Financial Overview** of the Kappa Delta Rho **Foundation**

he role of the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation is to provide ongoing financial support for the Kappa Delta Rho Fraternity, helping it to maintain its vitality and growth. With the generous support of our Alumni and friends, \$394,449 has been granted to the Fraternity for educational and leadership programming since 2016. In addition, \$726,699 in Chapter-specific, field of study-specific and needs-based scholarships have been awarded to Kappa Delta Rho undergraduates and Alumni during this time.

## ASSETS UNDER MANAGEMENT (as of June 30, 2022)



A primary responsibility of the Foundation is the management of the assets entrusted to us by the donors - past and present. The Foundation's Investment Committee supervises the management of all endowed funds. These funds include the general endowment, which supports the educational programming of the Fraternity, as well as the numerous scholarships designated to support the ongoing education of our active members and Alumni pursuing undergraduate and graduate degrees.

**\*** We raised \$130.0K from 316 donors for the Annual Fund, a 5.6% increase in dollars donated and an 8.2% increase in donors from the previous year.


- # We recorded our best "Giving Tuesday" since 2015, raising \$28.7K for the Annual Fund from 51 donors.
- The Foundation distributed over \$86.0K in endowed scholarships to approximately 60 exceptional Brothers.

As I have recalled several times before, I'm reminded of an article by the Foundation's then-President Thomas V. McComb, Nu '59, from the Spring/Summer 2006 Quill & Scroll, where he asked "each of you (17,500 living Alumni) who have not made a financial commitment to your Fraternity to do so. Four thousand (4,000) additional Alumni donors at a modest \$25 each would produce \$100,000 of additional funding annually - funding that is needed by your Fraternity to provide critical undergraduate programming, leadership training, and chapter development." As more Alumni answer the call, more Brothers experience the impact of KDR.

If you are already a donor, encourage a fellow Brother to join you in your generosity. Together, we can continue to make an impactful difference.

The Foundation fully supports the creation and endowment of new scholarships and has established policies governing restricted purpose and endowment funds consistent with applicable law. We account for these assets in separate funds based on fund purpose and donor-imposed restrictions. The Foundation seeks to preserve the corpus and utilize only earnings for all endowment funds with a current maximum payout rate of 5% (as defined in its Investment Policy Statement – revised 2011). An endowment fund is formed only upon the creation and acceptance by the Foundation of an Endowment Fund Agreement that conforms to relevant policy. In the past 18 months, eight new scholarship funds have been created that when fully endowed will provide over \$30,000 in financial assistance to KDR undergraduate Brothers.

Another service provided by the Foundation is offering short-term loans to Chapters in need through the Chapter Loan Fund. This Fund was established by the Trustees to make loans as an aid to Chapters or Alumni corporations of the Fraternity in building, remodeling, purchasing, financing or refinancing Chapter houses or for acquiring equipment, furnishings, or fixtures for the Chapter. All loan repayments including interest are retained within the Fund and recycled for future Chapter loans.

## Partnering with Alumni to Make a Difference for Chapters lota Beta's successful scholarship story

he Kappa Delta Rho Foundation fosters the establishment and distribution of needsbased and merit-based scholarships to undergraduate and post-graduate members of Kappa Delta Rho. One of the recently established and successful scholarship funds is the lota Beta Chapter Scholarship. One of the dedicated Alumni behind the creation of this Scholarship was **David A. Clark, IB '01**.

The success of the lota Beta Scholarship Fund is an example of how the Foundation works with Alumni groups to create endowed scholarship funds. The effort that Brother Clark and the other dedicated lota Beta (Rochester Institute of Technology) Brothers took to support their Chapter is a roadmap for other dedicated Alumni wishing to pursue a similar philanthropic path.

The lota Beta Alumni had created and fully funded the Paul Downes lota Beta Scholarship (PDIBS) several years ago. Then they found there was support for another fund that would award multiple scholarships annually in addition to the Downes Scholarship, which awards a single scholarship to an lota Beta Brother. Brother Clark initially discussed the idea of a second fund with Alok Kapoor, IB '93 and Paul Downes,  $\Lambda$  '68. Soon thereafter, a group of ten lota Beta Brothers had committed to support the funding and growth of the endowment.

Iota Beta Alumni contacted the Foundation to discuss creating a distinct structure wherein every qualified applicant receives a portion of the total stipend. Working with the Foundation came naturally as several of the Brothers have a long history of giving to the Foundation, and the Foundation could provide the flexibility to help them meet their goal.

The Alumni Corporation set a goal of raising \$20,000 per year over five years to create a \$100,000 fund capable of providing at least \$5,000 per year of financial assistance to RIT Brothers. Nearly 100 Alumni have stepped up and contributed to the fund with the encouragement of Brother Clark and other dedicated lota Beta Brothers. Approximately half of those donors have contributed each of the four years since inception. For the 2022-23 academic year, approximately \$2,900 was distributed to eight Brothers from the Rochester Institute of Technology that will defray a portion of their college tuition.

## Some of the key lessons learned by the lota Beta Brothers that other Alumni groups can utilize:

- Identify the core group of Brothers you think will donate and talk to them before committing to creating a scholarship.
- Know what you want the scholarship to be used for and how the award will be paid out.
- Create realistic goals: annual and final goal for the fund.
- Use social media to give recognition to the Brothers when they donate but don't say how much they gave.
- Give periodic updates of how far you are from your goal.
- Send a thank you to all donors, if possible, handwritten thank you cards or personal e-mails.
- Know your donors know who you can "bug" (remind) to donate and know which Brothers you ask once and that's it. You don't want to be too pushy, but you also want to remind that Brother to donate.
- Encourage recurring monthly donations. \$25 permonth is less intimidating than \$300 per-year.
- Remind Brothers about company matching. Some companies will match their employee's donation 1:1, a few even match 2:1.

Your Chapter can follow the lead of Iota Beta Alumni to make a big impact.




