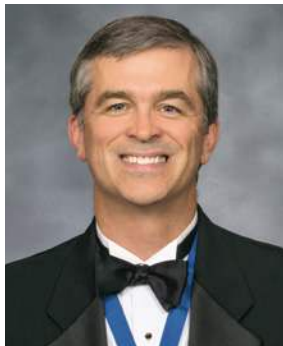

Making a Difference; Because of You!

It has been exciting to see the progress the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation has made in my second year as President. Because of your generosity, together we are doing more. More Alumni are receiving the message that their donations are “Making an Impactful Difference” in the lives of our undergraduate members. More Alumni are noticing the expanded Chapter programming that your contributions are supporting. More Brothers are receiving financial assistance with their scholastic endeavors than ever before.

The past twelve months have seen continued expansion of our outreach to our Alumni with positive feedback. My personal interactions with Alumni have shown that you care deeply about the Fraternity and are open to listening to how the Foundation is turning your generosity into positive outcomes for our Brotherhood. It is equally fun to hear the individual stories about how the Fraternity has shaped your adult lives. *These are the stories we need to continually highlight to demonstrate KDR as a lifetime Brotherhood.*

Here are just a few of the ways your generosity is having a positive impact on KDR.

Making a difference with Chapters

You helped the Foundation provide benefits to the Chapters through online education and increased officer training. The National Office developed an online education programming platform with funding from the Foundation that allows the Chapters to conduct most of their new member education and Chapter business online. In addition, based on the success of the Consul's Academy as a medium for leadership training, the Fraternity is expanding the concept through a platform called Optio to provide similar educational forums for Chapter Treasurers, Senior Tribunes, Junior Tribunes, and Secretaries.

Making a difference with Undergraduates

We have many undergraduate members that perform exceptionally well in and out of the classroom. They are active in their Chapter and in their community. That said, the increasing costs of higher education are a constant source of stress. The Foundation distributed over \$86,000 of endowed scholarships to nearly sixty outstanding Brothers. This is in addition to the New Member Scholarships that the Foundation offers. *These record results are not possible without the generosity of our Alumni.*

Making a difference with Brothers

So far, Alumni and friends have pledged over \$1.5M to the Brothers' Keeper capital campaign. College students today face complex challenges, and it is not uncommon for students to turn to alcohol and other drugs to relieve their stress and anxiety. With your financial support, Kappa Delta Rho is leading the Greek community by providing our undergraduates with the skills to be able to minimize the negative outcomes of stress and anxiety and the resources they need to find help. We will keep driving this initiative until our \$2.5M goal is met. You can find more information on this campaign and how to support it at kdr.com/foundation/brothers-keeper.

Making a difference with Alumni

Kappa Delta Rho is blessed with Alumni who care deeply about their Fraternity and their Chapters. Over the years, many Brothers have reached out to the Foundation to learn how they can increase their impact on their Chapters. This past year, the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation partnered with several Alumni groups and individuals to create four additional scholarship funds that provided the desired outcomes of financial support. Each of these new funds were fully endowed and distributed to worthy recipients in August. We can always build on this success, and the Foundation is prepared to collaborate with other Alumni to expand our scholarship offerings.

In closing, I want to thank the Foundation Trustees and the Fraternity Directors for the time and energy they give to our organization. The Trustees of the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation are dedicated to the work necessary to make our Fraternity stronger by raising the financial resources required to provide the services that our undergraduate members deserve.

You, the donors, are the backbone of our Fraternity. The Fraternity's success is a direct result of the financial support that you, the Brothers and benefactors of Kappa Delta Rho, have generously donated to the Foundation. Thank you!

More Alumni Answer the Call

What a remarkable year it has been for the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation. In the Foundation's 27-year history, this was our 10th best year for Annual Fund giving. When you consider that we have endured two-plus years of pandemic-induced uncertainty, I continue to be encouraged by our Alumni, undergraduate members, parents and friends of KDR, the National Office Staff, and everyone's ability to make an impact.

KDR continues to rise to the challenge of external situations, always responding so that our Fraternity can continue to focus on making a difference. Some of our impactful items from the year include:

- ✳ We raised \$130.0K from 316 donors for the Annual Fund, a 5.6% increase in dollars donated and an 8.2% increase in donors from the previous year.
- ✳ We recorded our best "Giving Tuesday" since 2015, raising \$28.7K for the Annual Fund from 51 donors.
- ✳ The Foundation distributed over \$86.0K in endowed scholarships to approximately 60 exceptional Brothers.
- ✳ KDR Alumni and friends have pledged over \$1.5M to the Brothers' Keeper Capital Campaign.

As I have recalled several times before, I'm reminded of an article by the Foundation's then-President Thomas V. McComb, Nu '59, from the Spring/Summer 2006 Quill & Scroll, where he asked "each of you (17,500 living Alumni) who have not made a financial commitment to your Fraternity to do so. Four thousand (4,000) additional Alumni donors at a modest \$25 each would produce \$100,000 of additional funding annually - funding that is needed by your Fraternity to provide critical undergraduate programming, leadership training, and chapter development." As more Alumni answer the call, more Brothers experience the impact of KDR.

If you are already a donor, encourage a fellow Brother to join you in your generosity. Together, we can continue to make an impactful difference.

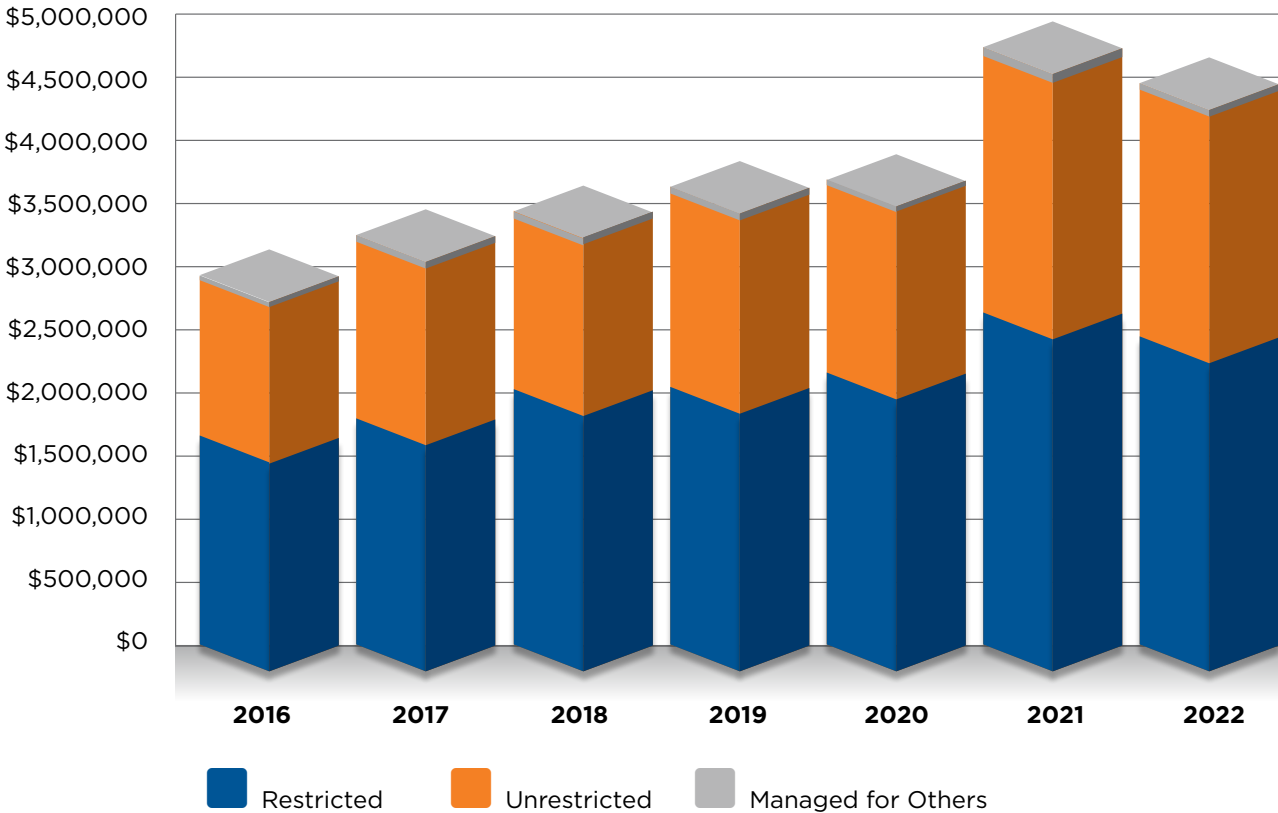
A Financial Overview of the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation

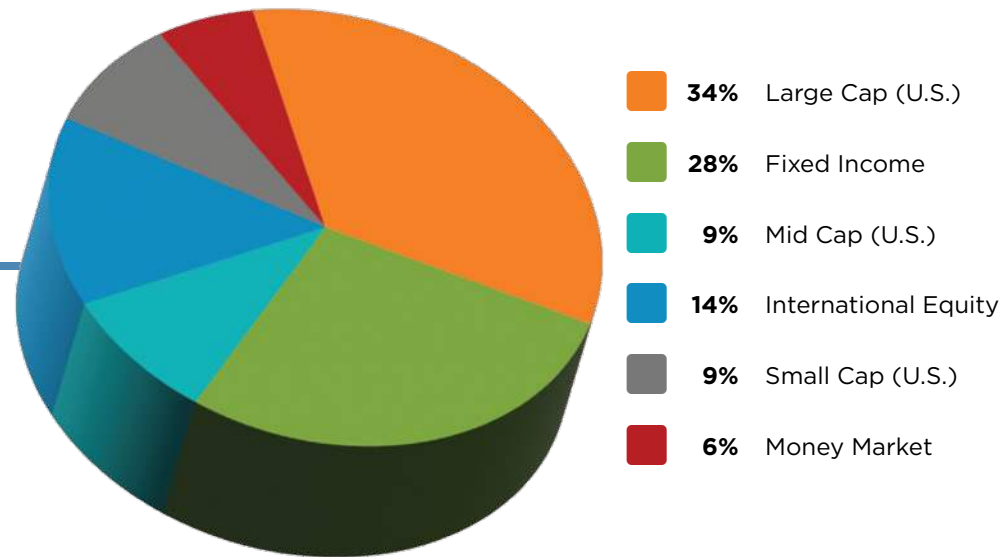
The role of the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation is to provide ongoing financial support for the Kappa Delta Rho Fraternity, helping it to maintain its vitality and growth. With the generous support of our Alumni and friends, \$394,449 has been granted to the Fraternity for educational and leadership programming since 2016. In addition, \$726,699 in Chapter-specific, field of study-specific and needs-based scholarships have been awarded to Kappa Delta Rho undergraduates and Alumni during this time.

ASSETS UNDER MANAGEMENT (as of June 30, 2022)



A primary responsibility of the Foundation is the management of the assets entrusted to us by the donors – past and present. The Foundation's Investment Committee supervises the management of all endowed funds. These funds include the general endowment, which supports the educational programming of the Fraternity, as well as the numerous scholarships designated to support the ongoing education of our active members and Alumni pursuing undergraduate and graduate degrees.

ASSET ALLOCATION (as of June 30, 2022)



The Foundation fully supports the creation and endowment of new scholarships and has established policies governing restricted purpose and endowment funds consistent with applicable law. We account for these assets in separate funds based on fund purpose and donor-imposed restrictions. The Foundation seeks to preserve the corpus and utilize only earnings for all endowment funds with a current maximum payout rate of 5% (as defined in its Investment Policy Statement – revised 2011). An endowment fund is formed only upon the creation and acceptance by the Foundation of an Endowment Fund Agreement that conforms to relevant policy. In the past 18 months, eight new scholarship funds have been created that when fully endowed will provide over \$30,000 in financial assistance to KDR undergraduate Brothers.

Another service provided by the Foundation is offering short-term loans to Chapters in need through the Chapter Loan Fund. This Fund was established by the Trustees to make loans as an aid to Chapters or Alumni corporations of the Fraternity in building, remodeling, purchasing, financing or refinancing Chapter houses or for acquiring equipment, furnishings, or fixtures for the Chapter. All loan repayments including interest are retained within the Fund and recycled for future Chapter loans.

Partnering with Alumni to Make a Difference for Chapters Iota Beta's successful scholarship story

The Kappa Delta Rho Foundation fosters the establishment and distribution of needs-based and merit-based scholarships to undergraduate and post-graduate members of Kappa Delta Rho. One of the recently established and successful scholarship funds is the Iota Beta Chapter Scholarship. One of the dedicated Alumni behind the creation of this Scholarship was **David A. Clark, IB '01**.

The success of the Iota Beta Scholarship Fund is an example of how the Foundation works with Alumni groups to create endowed scholarship funds. The effort that Brother Clark and the other dedicated Iota Beta (Rochester Institute of Technology) Brothers took to support their Chapter is a roadmap for other dedicated Alumni wishing to pursue a similar philanthropic path.

The Iota Beta Alumni had created and fully funded the Paul Downes Iota Beta Scholarship (PDIBS) several years ago. Then they found there was support for another fund that would award multiple scholarships annually in addition to the Downes Scholarship, which awards a single scholarship to an Iota Beta Brother. Brother Clark initially discussed the idea of a second fund with Alok Kapoor, IB '93 and Paul Downes, A '68. Soon thereafter, a group of ten Iota Beta Brothers had committed to support the funding and growth of the endowment.

Iota Beta Alumni contacted the Foundation to discuss creating a distinct structure wherein every qualified applicant receives a portion of the total stipend. Working with the Foundation came naturally as several of the Brothers have a long history of giving to the Foundation, and the Foundation could provide the flexibility to help them meet their goal.

The Alumni Corporation set a goal of raising \$20,000 per year over five years to create a \$100,000 fund capable of providing at least \$5,000 per year of financial assistance to RIT Brothers. Nearly 100 Alumni have stepped up and contributed to the fund with the encouragement of Brother Clark and other dedicated Iota Beta Brothers. Approximately half of those donors have contributed each of the four years since inception. For the 2022-23 academic year, approximately \$2,900 was distributed to eight Brothers from the Rochester Institute of Technology that will defray a portion of their college tuition.

Some of the key lessons learned by the Iota Beta Brothers that other Alumni groups can utilize:

- Identify the core group of Brothers you think will donate and talk to them before committing to creating a scholarship.
- Know what you want the scholarship to be used for and how the award will be paid out.
- Create realistic goals: annual and final goal for the fund.
- Use social media to give recognition to the Brothers when they donate but don't say how much they gave.
- Give periodic updates of how far you are from your goal.
- Send a thank you to all donors, if possible, hand-written thank you cards or personal e-mails.
- Know your donors – know who you can “bug” (remind) to donate and know which Brothers you ask once and that's it. You don't want to be too pushy, but you also want to remind that Brother to donate.
- Encourage recurring monthly donations. \$25 per-month is less intimidating than \$300 per-year.
- Remind Brothers about company matching. Some companies will match their employee's donation 1:1, a few even match 2:1.

Your Chapter can follow the lead of Iota Beta Alumni to make a big impact.

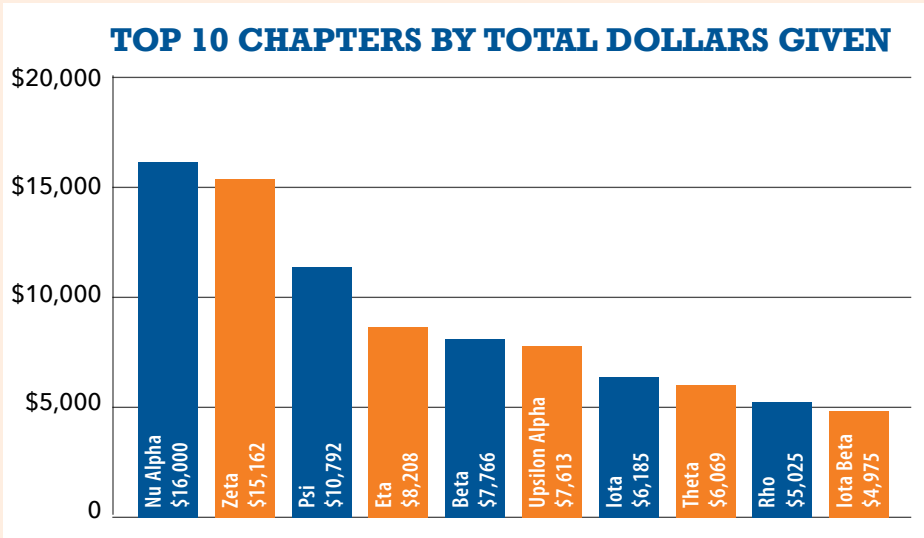
