A Lifetime of Impact: Because of You!

We proudly present you with the 2023-24 edition of the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation Impact Report. As we look back on the past year and forward to 2024-25, we want to highlight how the foundation is “charting the impact” that our undergraduates receive from generous Alumni who follow our motto, “Honor above all things!”

First, I would like to thank the Foundation Trustees and Fraternity Directors for the time and energy they dedicate to our Brotherhood. These Brothers, as well as many volunteers, are dedicated to the work necessary to strengthen our Fraternity by raising the financial resources required to provide the services our undergraduate members deserve. We never forget that you, the donors, are the back bone of our Fraternity.

This time last year, I was communicating with you about the uncertainty regarding the personnel changes at KDRHQ, the optimism that was beginning to pervade our active Chapters, and the progress that we were making expanding support from the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation. As I look back over the past twelve months, it is clear that Kappa Delta Rho is progressing in the right direction with KDRHQ, our Chapters, and our host universities working together collaboratively and constructively for the betterment of the community at large.

The Foundation is working hard to spread the word about our positive impact on the young men on campus, and the results are showing up in our Annual Fund statistics.

- * The annual fund experienced a 10% increase in donors, and a record 64% retention of existing donors year over year.
- * The Foundation saw the highest level of first-time donors in five years and a significant number of recovered donors from prior years.
- * Over a dozen donors made their first gift to the Foundation in at least 15 years.
- * Partnering with CrowdChange, we saw a 120% increase in contributions on #GivingTuesday.

Kappa Delta Rho is making the case for support, and we are grateful for the positive response we are receiving from Alumni. In addition to growing the annual fund to support educational programming, we remain focused on working with dedicated Alumni to expand our scholarship offerings.

In the past 12 months, we formalized new scholarship funds to benefit our Brothers at Franklin College, the University of California – Berkeley, and Indiana University.

- * The Foundation distributed a record-breaking \$110,000 of endowed scholarships in 2024.
- * Since the Foundation's inception, more than \$1,800,000 has been dispensed to further the academic endeavors of Brothers of KDR.
- * Eleven new scholarship funds were created over the last four years in partnership with dedicated Alumni who provided financial support for members of their respective Chapters.

We are blessed to have such generous Alumni. It is an honor to help them leave a legacy of generosity to the fraternity they love!

As a result of the Brothers' Keeper initiative, Kappa Delta Rho has partnered with MANUAL Care, a program designed by public health professionals, behavior change experts, and higher education professionals to improve the academic outcomes and overall well-being of young men on campus. They hosted an informative session during the Elmon Williams Leadership School this summer. This report features an article capturing the experience from a participant's perspective.

The Kappa Delta Rho Foundation's priorities remain the same:

- * Expand our scholarship offerings to financially support the scholastic endeavors of our Brothers
- * Build on the strength of the Annual Fund to expand the support our Chapters receive from KDRHQ.
- * Grow our endowment dollars through direct contributions and estate plan gifts to ensure the long-term prosperity of our Fraternity.

These educational resources and experiences would not be possible without Brothers like you and the financial support you provide to the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation. As the Foundation charts our Alumni contributions' positive impact, we will explore additional ways to directly support our young men on campus. I want to thank you for your dedication and generous support of Kappa Delta Rho, your faith in the Foundation to be good stewards of your contributions, and your belief in **Honor Super Omnia!**

KDR's Impact: Pay It Forward

As this is my first annual impact report letter, a brief introduction is in order. My name is Scott M. Smaniotto, Alpha Beta '93, and I live in Trumbull, Connecticut, with Suzanne, my wife of 29 years. We have two adult children: Christopher, an EMT and Army Reservist, and Anthony, a junior Mechanical Engineering major at my alma mater, the University of Delaware. I was raised in New Jersey, went to school in Delaware, and moved to Connecticut to work for GE Capital, now Synchrony. Looking back at Kappa Delta Rho's **impact** on my life with lifelong friends, key milestones, and unforgettable memories, I shudder to think what my life would have been like without KDR. She supported me when I made a tough decision to change major during my sophomore year. She was there again when I pinned my future wife at our Rose Formal. She was there at countless Brothers' weddings, including mine, when I stood as best man, groomsman, or a happy guest. She was even there at a few baptisms where my wife and I had the honor to stand as godparents for a couple of Brothers' children. Even after graduation, she continued to drive me to serve as VP of the Alpha Beta Alumni Corporation, National Board of Directors, National Treasurer, National VP, Finance & Administration, and recently, to join the Foundation as Trustee and now, VP, Development & Communication. I tell you these things so



you appreciate the **impact** KDR has had on me, and I can't imagine what it would have been like without her.

A few highlights on last year's impact:

- ✳ We raised more than \$117,800 for the Annual Fund, with the support of 284 donors, including more than 30 first-time donors.
- ✳ On Giving Tuesday, November 2023, we raised more than \$22,000 due to the generosity of 95 donors.
- ✳ On Founder's Day, May 2024, we had another successful effort, securing more than \$6,000 in total donations from more than 30 donors.

An update on where the Brother's Keeper campaign stands:

- ✳ 77% of pledges have been paid in full, with 65 Brothers actively making payments over the past two fiscal years.

Everything I enumerated above about my life would not have been possible without the support of the Brothers who came before me. As those past Brothers **impacted** me, we now must support the Foundation and Fraternity in ways that will **impact** the future men of KDR. Thankfully, the recent successes outlined above demonstrate the willingness of our Brotherhood to take on that mantle and pay it forward to the next generation of Brothers.

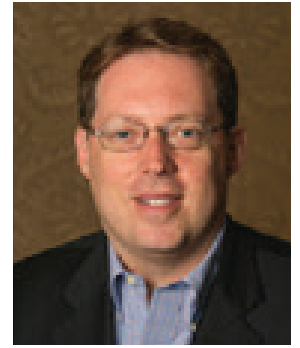

A Financial Overview of the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation

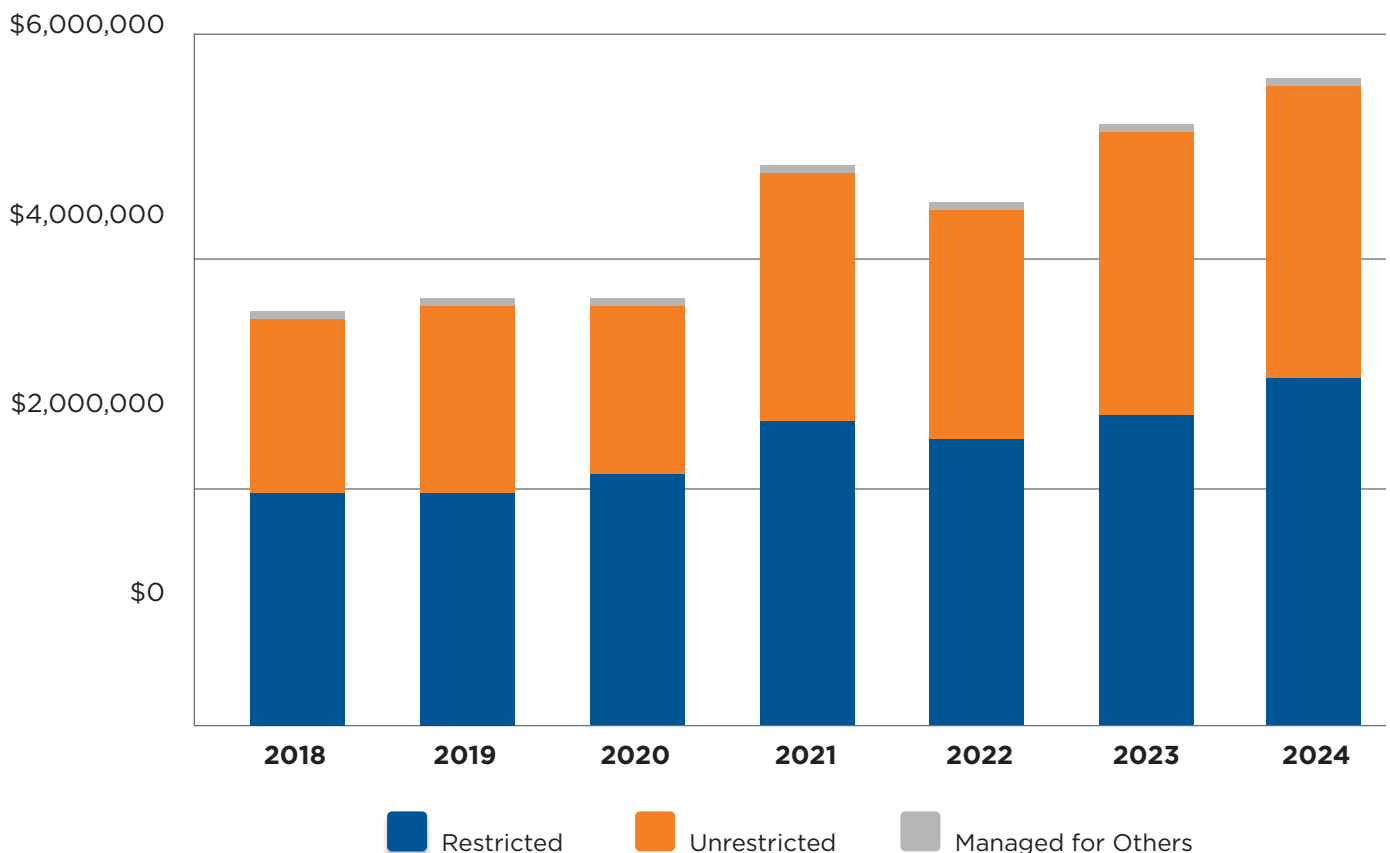

The role of the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation is to provide ongoing financial support for the Kappa Delta Rho Fraternity, helping it to maintain its vitality and growth. With the generous support of our Brothers and friends, **more than \$375,000 has been granted to the Fraternity** for educational and leadership programming since 2018. In addition, **more than \$500,000 in Chapter-specific, field of study specific, and needs-based scholarships** have been awarded to Kappa Delta Rho undergraduates and Alumni during this time.

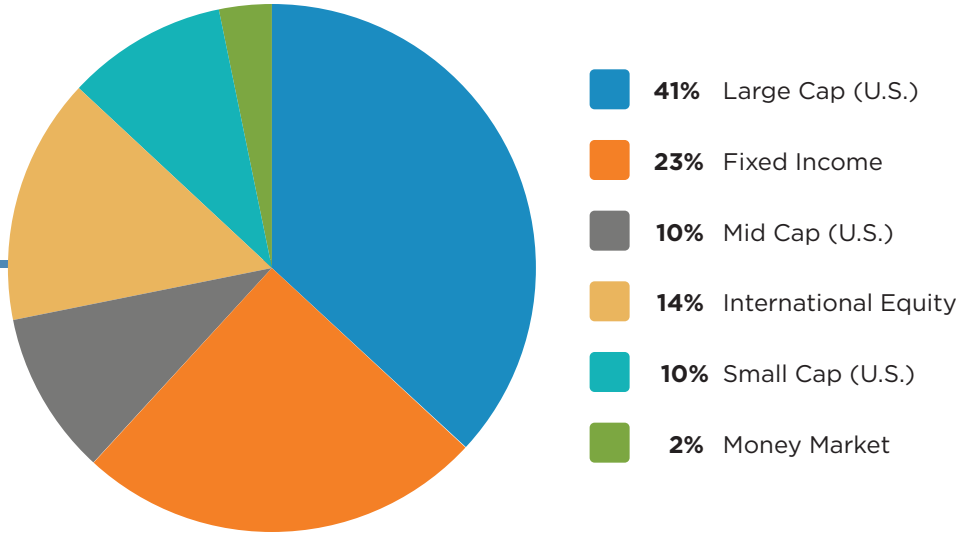
A primary responsibility of the Foundation is managing the assets entrusted to us by the donors, past and present. The Foundation's Investment Committee supervises the management of all endowed funds. These funds include the general endowment, which supports the educational programming of the Fraternity, and the numerous scholarships designated to support the ongoing education of our active members and alums pursuing undergraduate and graduate degrees.

The Foundation fosters the creation and endowment of new scholarships and has policies governing restricted purpose and endowment funds consistent with applicable law. We account for these assets in separate funds based on fund purposes and donor-imposed restrictions. The Foundation seeks to expand the corpus and utilize earnings for all restricted funds with a current maximum payout rate of 5%, as defined in its Investment Policy Statement,

revised 2011. A restricted-purpose fund is formed only upon the creation and acceptance by the Foundation of a Fund Agreement that conforms to relevant policy. **We have helped Alumni establish 11 new scholarships in the past four years.** We welcome the opportunity to provide additional information to those interested in the rewarding experience of creating a fund to provide scholarships for current and future Brothers.

Another service of the Foundation is to provide short term loans to Chapters through the Chapter Loan Fund. The Trustees established this fund to make loans to aid Chapters or Alumni corporations of the Fraternity in building, remodeling, purchasing, financing, or refinancing Chapter

houses or acquiring equipment, furnishings, or fixtures for the Chapter. All loan repayments, including interest, are retained within the fund and recycled for future Chapter loans. There is currently one loan outstanding to the Kappa Chapter at The Ohio State University.

Foundation Adds Brother Jarrard to Trustee Board

The Kappa Delta Rho Foundation is excited to welcome Matthew D. Jarrard, Epsilon '05, to the Foundation Board of Trustees. He will serve a three-year term and bring a lifetime of fundraising experience to the Foundation. Brother Jarrard was very active in his Chapter, including serving as the Chapter's Senior Tribune. As an alumnus, he has supported the Epsilon Chapter and Housing Corporation as Co-chair of the Advancement Committee, focusing on Chapter Alumni engagement efforts.

Matt is currently the Director of Development for Youth Villages, an organization committed to radically improving the lives of children across the country through an array of program models and services built around preserving and restoring families. He began his 19-year career in non-profit organizations with the Boy Scouts of America and served the KDR Foundation through his position with The Laurus Group from 2008 to 2012. He later held leadership

fundraising positions at the Booth Western Art Museum and Woodruff Arts Center in Atlanta, Georgia, receiving his Certified Fundraising Executive (CFRE) designation in 2016.

In 2019, Brother Jarrard served as Co-chair of the Epsilon Chapter's Centennial Banquet, celebrating the 100th anniversary of the Chapter's founding at Franklin

College. Active in the Atlanta community, Matt has served on boards for the Committee for a Better Atlanta, Georgia Planned Giving Council and is a graduate of the Atlanta Regional Commission's Arts Leaders of Metro Atlanta program. He has been an active member of the Rotary Club of Vinings-Cumberland Georgia for more than 10 years and served as club President from 2023-2024.



Mental Health Care for the Fraternity Man

The Kappa Delta Rho Foundation's mission is to financially support the educational, leadership, and character development programs undertaken by the National Fraternity of Kappa Delta Rho. To fulfill its mission, the Foundation launched the **Brothers' Keeper Capital Campaign** to fund a multifaceted program intended to develop positive health and mental health behaviors and habits, as well as educate and encourage Brothers to reach out for professional help for themselves or a friend when in distress. As our Brothers' keeper, we should be aware of possible warning signs and subtle calls for help. We do not have to be mental health professionals to recognize someone else's difficulties or our own and seek assistance.

As a result of a grant made possible by Kappa Delta Rho's Brothers' Keeper Capital Campaign, KDRHQ has partnered with MANUAL Care, a digital platform supporting college-aged men in their mental health journey. MANUAL's evidence-based, expert-led online platform provides accessible and engaging content to tens of thousands of young men, covering a wide range of topics including mental health, sexual health, nutrition, fitness, and overall



well-being. This platform will empower students to make informed decisions that will improve their ability to perform their best in class and beyond. The Kappa Chapter at The Ohio State University has been fortunate enough to participate in this pilot program.

Every day, I read the quote, "May our Brotherhood always embrace our imperfect Brothers," written on a white board in my apartment. We are all imperfect Brothers, impacted by our lived experiences, good and bad. I am grateful to see our men be given the opportunity to share our imperfections and be vulnerable in a safe space. For as much pride as we all take in being our Brother's keeper, sometimes that effort can be easier said than done. In these situations, I believe MANUAL has been an incredible resource not only for myself but for the men in my Chapter. There are unique struggles that come with being a college-aged man. Admitting those struggles to another man, even someone you consider a Brother, can be difficult. Since we've begun participating in this program, I have seen our fraternal bonds grow closer and our Chapter's culture as a whole improve distinctly.

I look forward to continuing this partnership and am excited to see how it develops. HSO!

Kappa Delta Rho Joins the Interfraternal Giving Tuesday Challenge

The Greek Community on college campuses plays a vital role in the lives of students by fostering a sense of belonging and camaraderie. Fraternities and sororities offer a supportive network, fostering personal growth, leadership development, and lifelong friendship. This sense of camaraderie within the Greek Community led the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation to participate in the Interfraternal Giving Tuesday Challenge (IGTC) in 2023.

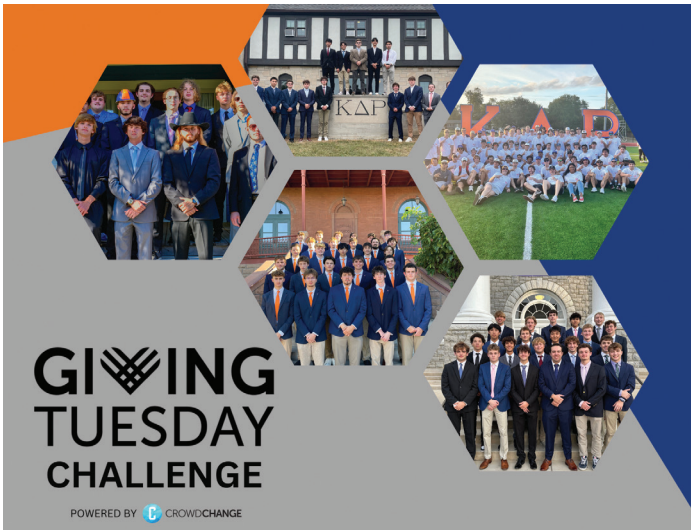
The IGTC started in 2021 as a friendly competition between fraternity foundations to see which organization could generate the most engagement on Giving Tuesday, with the purpose of elevating overall fundraising efforts.

As a result of joining forces and cross-promoting with other Greek foundations, KDR had one of our most successful Giving Tuesday campaigns, raising over \$22,000 from 95 donors, including 20 first-time donors.

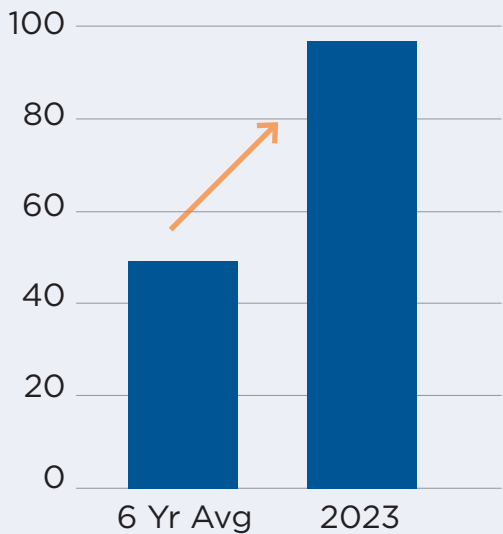
Our results included:

- ✳ Exceeding our initial donation goal by over 10%.
- ✳ Raising over 50% more than our six-year average on Giving Tuesday.
- ✳ Securing 50% more donors than any past Giving Tuesday and doubling our six-year average.

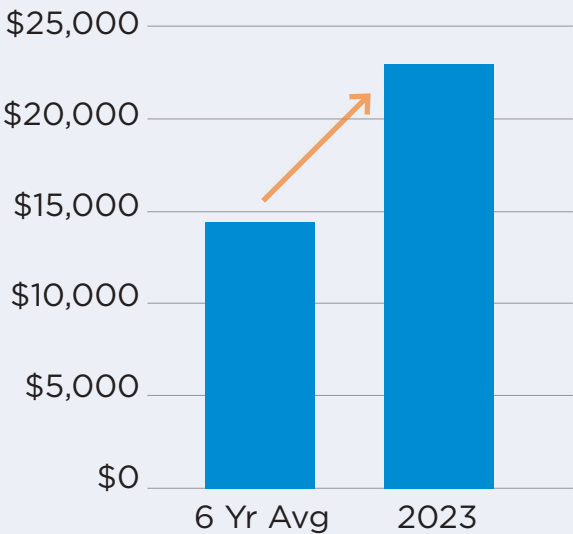

The New Member Academic Achievement Scholarship is intended to acknowledge and assist members who consistently maintain academic excellence during their first semester as a Brother. It is awarded to individuals who attain a GPA of 3.0 or higher during the semester in which they join and continue to meet the good standing criteria with the National Fraternity. This \$100 scholarship is disbursed directly to the university and allocated towards covering the Brother's tuition fees.

- ✳ Only actual donations, not pledges to donate. Matching gifts are included in individual totals where possible.
- ✳ It does not include giving to individual Chapters (as we do not have this information).
- ✳ It only applies to individuals, not giving from Alumni corporations or associations.

- ✳ Includes living and deceased Brothers (we have more than 30 years of historical information).

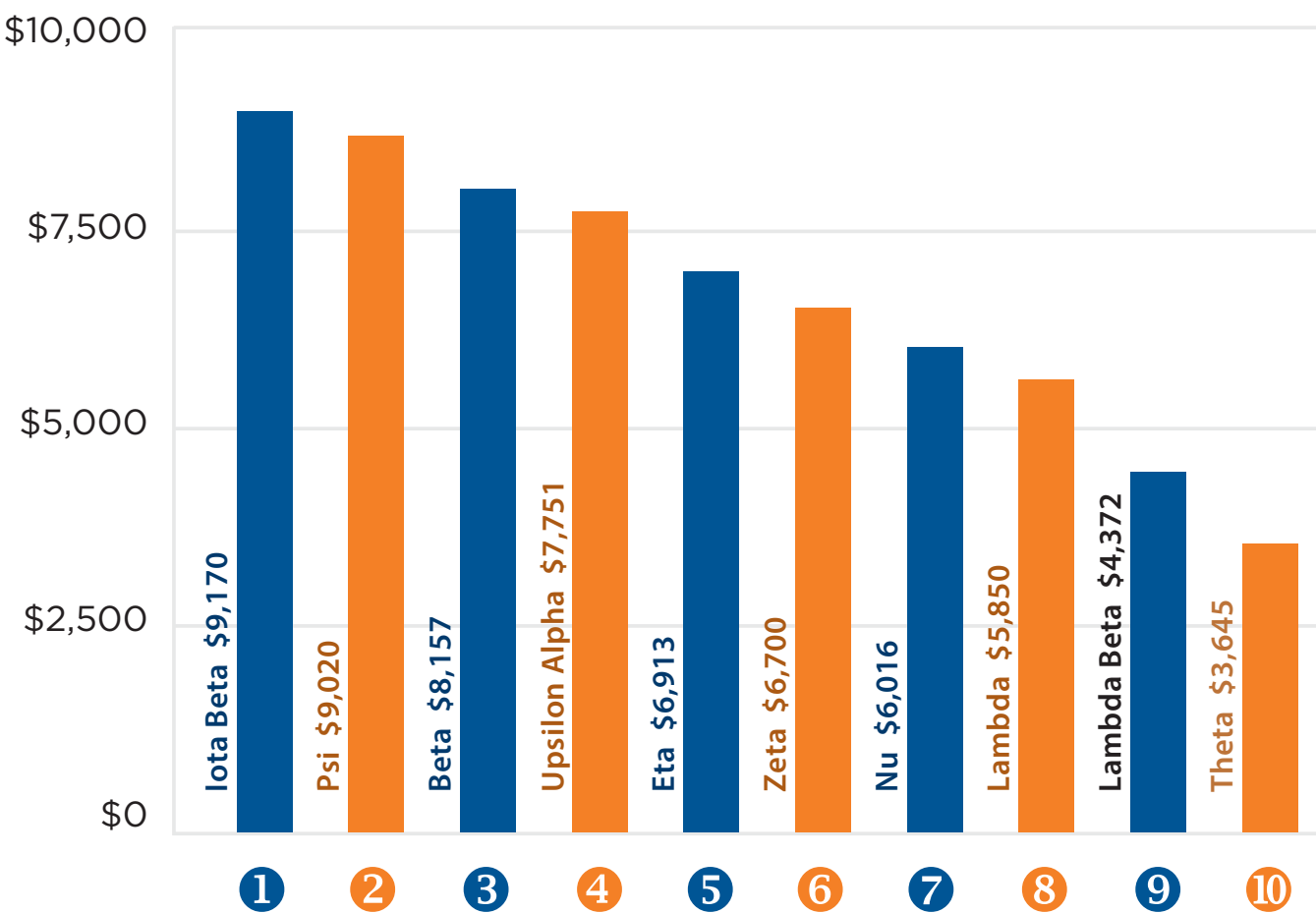
