Brothers:

We are proud to present you with the 2024-25 edition of the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation Impact Report. As we look back on 2024-25 and look forward to 2025-26, we wanted to highlight how you are helping the Foundation in **"Building Our Legacy"** for future generations. The current Foundation Trustees and volunteers humbly carry the mantle of responsibility to steward the Foundation to greater heights! **Indeed, it is incumbent on all of us to build on the groundwork that our predecessors laid before us** and help provide the time, talent, and treasure that our Brotherhood needs to develop the next generation of Fraternity, community, and corporate leaders.

I want to thank the Foundation Trustees, the Fraternity Directors, and numerous volunteers for the time and energy they give to our Brotherhood. All these Brothers are dedicated to the work necessary to make our Fraternity stronger by raising the financial resources required to provide the services that our undergraduate members deserve. **You**, the donors, are the backbone of our Fraternity.

This time last year, I commented about the optimism that was beginning to pervade our active Chapters and the progress that we were making in expanding our support of our undergraduate members. As I look back over the past twelve months, it is clear that Kappa Delta Rho is progressing in the right direction with KDRHQ, our Chapters, and our host universities working together collaboratively and constructively for the betterment of the community at large.

The Foundation is working hard to spread the word about the positive impact we are having on the young men on campus, and the results are showing up in our Annual Fund statistics.

- ✱ **The Annual Fund experienced a 6% increase in donors and dollars and a record 65% retention in existing donors year over year.**
- ✱ **The Foundation saw the highest level of first-time donors in five years, as well as a significant number of recovered donors from prior years.**
- ✱ **Fifteen donors made their first gift to the Foundation in at least 15 years.**
- ✱ **We executed two successful Days of Giving (#GivingTuesday and Founder's Day).**

- ✱ **We revamped our Planned Giving website to include more estate planning guidance for those Brothers interested in securing their long-term support of Kappa Delta Rho.**

Kappa Delta Rho is making the case for support, and we are grateful for the positive response we are receiving from Alumni. I believe that the building blocks are in place for us to meaningfully grow the Annual Fund so as to achieve the goals that we set several years ago. However, while the "trend is our friend," we can still get better.

- ✱ **The amount raised for the Annual Fund continues our post-COVID improvement, but still lags the prior decade's average.**
- ✱ **The number of Annual Fund contributors increased for the second year in a row, but remains below our historical average and represents a small percentage of our Alumni base.**

In addition to growing the Annual Fund to support educational programming, we remain focused on working with dedicated Alumni to expand our Scholarship offerings.

- ✱ **Over \$110,000 of endowed scholarships were distributed by the Foundation for the 2024-25 academic year.**
- ✱ **Nearly \$2M has been dispensed to further the academic endeavors of Brothers of KDR since the Foundation's inception.**
- ✱ **We did not initiate any new scholarships this year, but our program continues to grow through additional contributions. We are deep in discussions with several Alumni that should allow us to offer stipends in additional educational areas in the next year.**

We are blessed to have such generous Alumni, and it is an honor to help them leave a legacy of generosity to the Fraternity they love!

Kappa Delta Rho is expanding our partnership with MANUAL thanks to the funds raised during our Brother's Keeper initiative. MANUAL is a program designed by public health professionals, behavior change experts, and higher education professionals to improve the academic outcomes and overall well-being of young men on college campuses. As we continue to grow our relationship with MANUAL, we

As each of us plots our own course through life, we shape the past, present, and future of Kappa Delta Rho, forging her legacy along with our own. It is the volunteers who advise our Chapters, raise money, and guide our strategic direction. It is the donors who make award-winning programs like the Legion and Brothers' Keeper a reality. It is the office and field staff who make sure we all stay pointed in the same direction: forward. It is the directors and trustees who give selflessly of their own time, talent,

and treasure to give back to something that has given so much to them. It is all the members of the Ordo Honoris, honored for their contributions to their communities, industries, businesses, and KDR. Collectively, we are KDR, and she is us, forever bound in oath and cause.

A few highlights on last year's impact:

- ✳ We raised over \$121,000 for the Annual Fund, with the support of 304 donors, including 46 first-time donors.
- ✳ On Giving Tuesday (November 2024), we raised over \$20,000 due to the generosity of 81 donors.
- ✳ On Founder's Day (May 2025), we had another successful effort, securing nearly \$10,000 in total donations.

An update on where the Brother's Keeper Campaign stands:

- ✳ 77% of pledges have been paid in full, with 65 Brothers actively making payments over the past two fiscal years.

I ask you to explore what you can do for KDR. Whether it's volunteering at the local or national level or donating to the Foundation to support the many worthwhile programs for our undergraduate Brothers, there is a wealth of opportunities to get involved. Will you join me in "**Building Our Legacy**"?

- ✳ **Grow our endowment dollars through direct contributions and estate plan gifts to ensure the long-term prosperity of our Fraternity.**

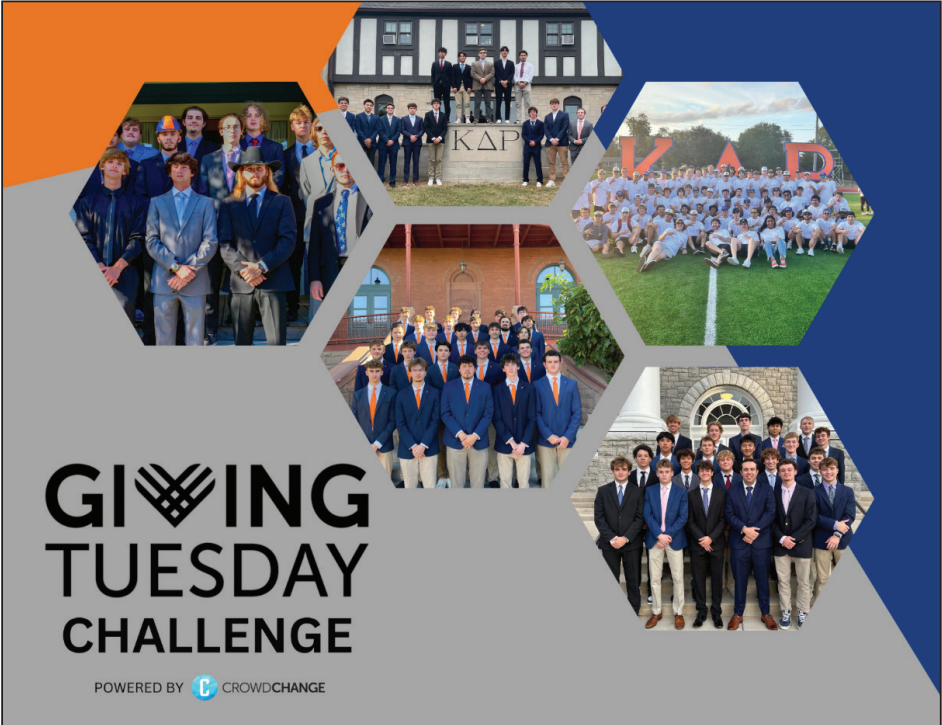

Expanding our Reach: The Interfraternal Giving Tuesday Challenge

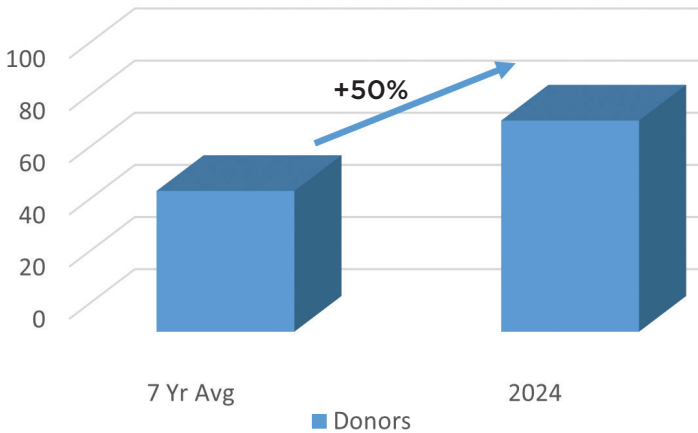
Building off our 2023 success, Kappa Delta Rho again participated in the Interfraternal Giving Tuesday Challenge to compete with other Greek organizations to see which Foundation can raise the most money. The Interfraternal Giving Tuesday Challenge is a friendly competition between fraternity foundations to see which organization can rally the most engagement and raise the most for its annual (unrestricted) fund on Giving Tuesday. **In 2024, we again saw strong results with over \$20,000 raised from over 80 Brothers.**

Due to the rising cost of education for undergraduate members, and KDRHQ's efforts to provide leadership resources for our Chapters, Kappa Delta Rho's need for support is greater today than it has been at any point in our history. Thanks to the success of the 2024 Interfraternal Giving Tuesday Challenge, **Kappa Delta Rho increased the stipend for**

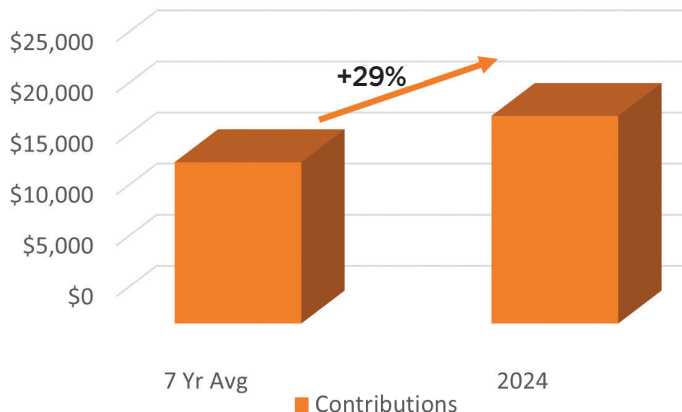


the New Member Scholarship from \$100 to \$250, helping to defray the cost of membership for our Brothers. Any Brother who maintains at least a 3.0 GPA during their pledge semester is eligible for this scholarship.

Securing a Home for Kappa: Chapter Loan Fund Success Story



The Trustees of the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation established the Chapter Loan Fund to aid Chapters or Alumni Corporations in building, remodeling, purchasing, financing, or refinancing Chapter houses or acquiring equipment, furnishings, or fixtures for the Chapter. Several Chapters improved their on-campus competitive positioning by borrowing from the corpus of the Fund. The Kappa Chapter at The Ohio State University recently accessed the Fund to secure housing for the Chapter. Their testimonial follows.

The Kappa Chapter sought a loan from the Chapter Loan Fund to cover the down payment on our Chapter house. Securing a permanent home for the Brotherhood was a significant financial undertaking, and the upfront costs were beyond what the Chapter could absorb on its own through dues and fundraising alone.

We turned to the KDR Foundation's Chapter Loan Fund because it offered terms and a level of trust that a traditional lender simply could not match. Knowing that the

Foundation understood our mission and had the Chapter's best interests in mind made the decision an easy one. It allowed us to move forward with confidence rather than uncertainty.

Having a Chapter house has made a lasting difference for Kappa. It has given our Brotherhood a dedicated space to meet, grow, and build the kind of bonds that define the fraternity experience. The house has become central to everything we do, from recruitment to Brotherhood events to day-to-day Chapter life.

Partnering with the Foundation was a smooth and straightforward process. If a similar financial need arose in the future, we would not hesitate to utilize the Chapter Loan Fund again, and we would encourage other Chapters to consider it as well.

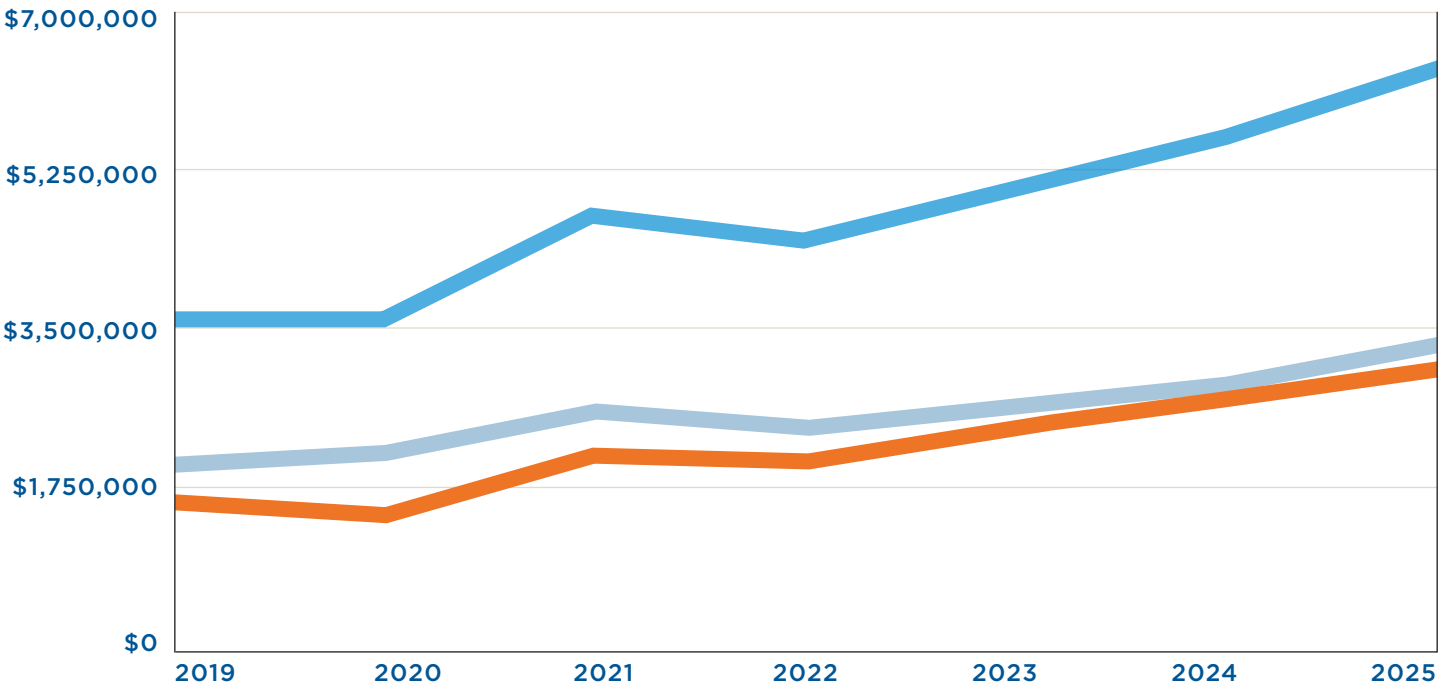

The role of the Kappa Delta Rho Foundation is to provide ongoing financial support for the Kappa Delta Rho Fraternity, helping it to maintain its vitality and growth. With the generous support of our Brothers and friends, more than **\$400,000 has been granted to the Fraternity for educational and leadership programming since 2019. In addition, over \$500,000 in Chapter-specific, field of study, and needs-based scholarships** have been awarded to Kappa Delta Rho undergraduates and Alumni during this time.

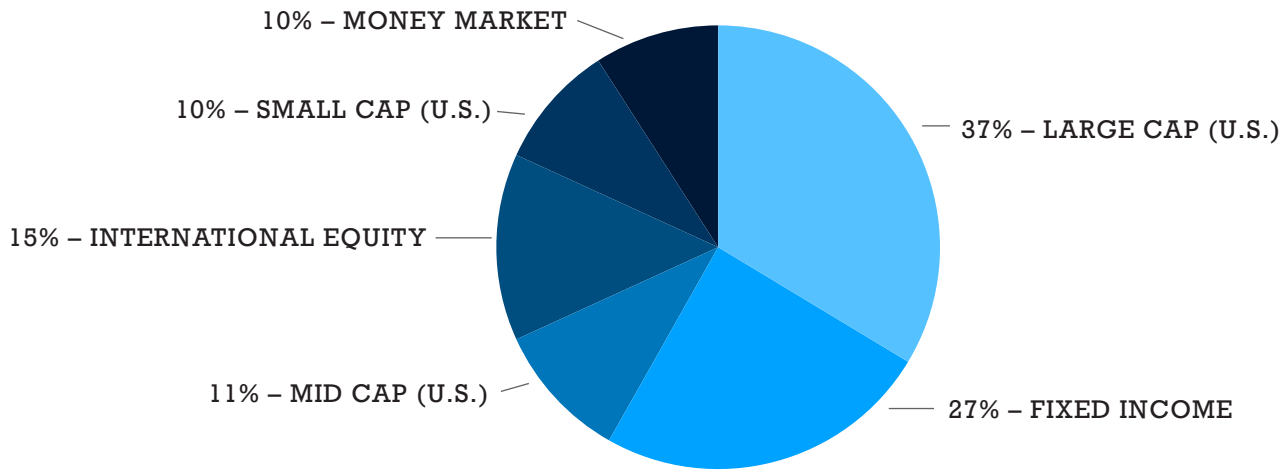
A primary responsibility of the Foundation is to manage the assets entrusted to us by the donors—past and present. The Foundation’s Investment Committee supervises the management of all endowed funds. These funds include the general endowment, which supports the educational programming of the Fraternity, as well as the funds dedicated to Brothers’ Keeper and the numerous scholarships designated to support the ongoing educational pursuits of our active Brothers pursuing undergraduate and graduate degrees.

The Foundation fosters the creation and endowment of new scholarships and has policies governing restricted purpose and unrestricted funds consistent with applicable law. We account for these assets in separate funds based on fund purposes and donor-imposed restrictions.

The Foundation seeks to invest the corpus in a diversified set of equity and debt mutual funds and predominantly utilizes earnings for distributions from all restricted funds with a current maximum payout rate of 5% (as defined in

its Investment Policy Statement-revised 2011). A restricted-purpose fund is formed only upon the creation and acceptance by the Foundation of a Fund Agreement that conforms to relevant policy.

We have partnered with Alumni to establish eleven new scholarship funds in the past five years, and welcome the opportunity to provide additional information to those interested in the rewarding experience of creating a fund to provide scholarships for current and future Brothers.

Another Foundation service that the Investment Committee oversees is offering short-term loans to Chapters in need through the Chapter Loan Fund.

The Trustees established this Fund to make loans to aid Chapters or Alumni Corporations of the Fraternity in building, remodeling, purchasing, financing, or refinancing

Chapter houses or acquiring equipment, furnishings, or fixtures for the Chapter. All loan repayments, including interest, are retained within the Fund and recycled for future Chapter loans. There is currently one loan outstanding to the Kappa Chapter at The Ohio State University with approximately \$75,000 available to be borrowed.

2024–2025 NEW MEMBER ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP

The New Member Academic Achievement Scholarship is intended to acknowledge and assist members who consistently maintain academic excellence during their first semester as a Brother. It is awarded to individuals who attain a GPA of 3.0 or higher during the semester in which they join and continue to meet the good standing criteria with the National Fraternity. **Beginning in the 2025-26 academic year, the Foundation increased the stipend for the New Member Scholarship from \$100 to \$250 to further defray the cost of membership for our Brothers.**

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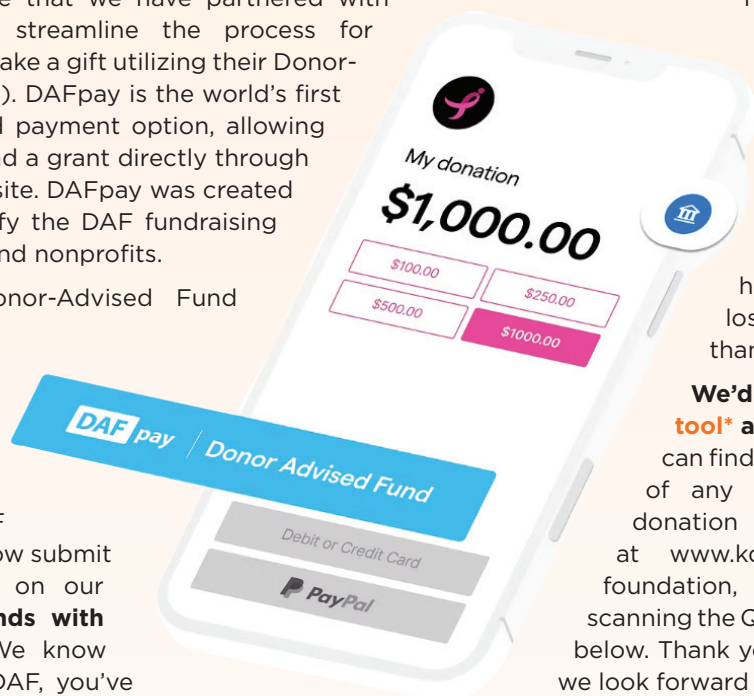

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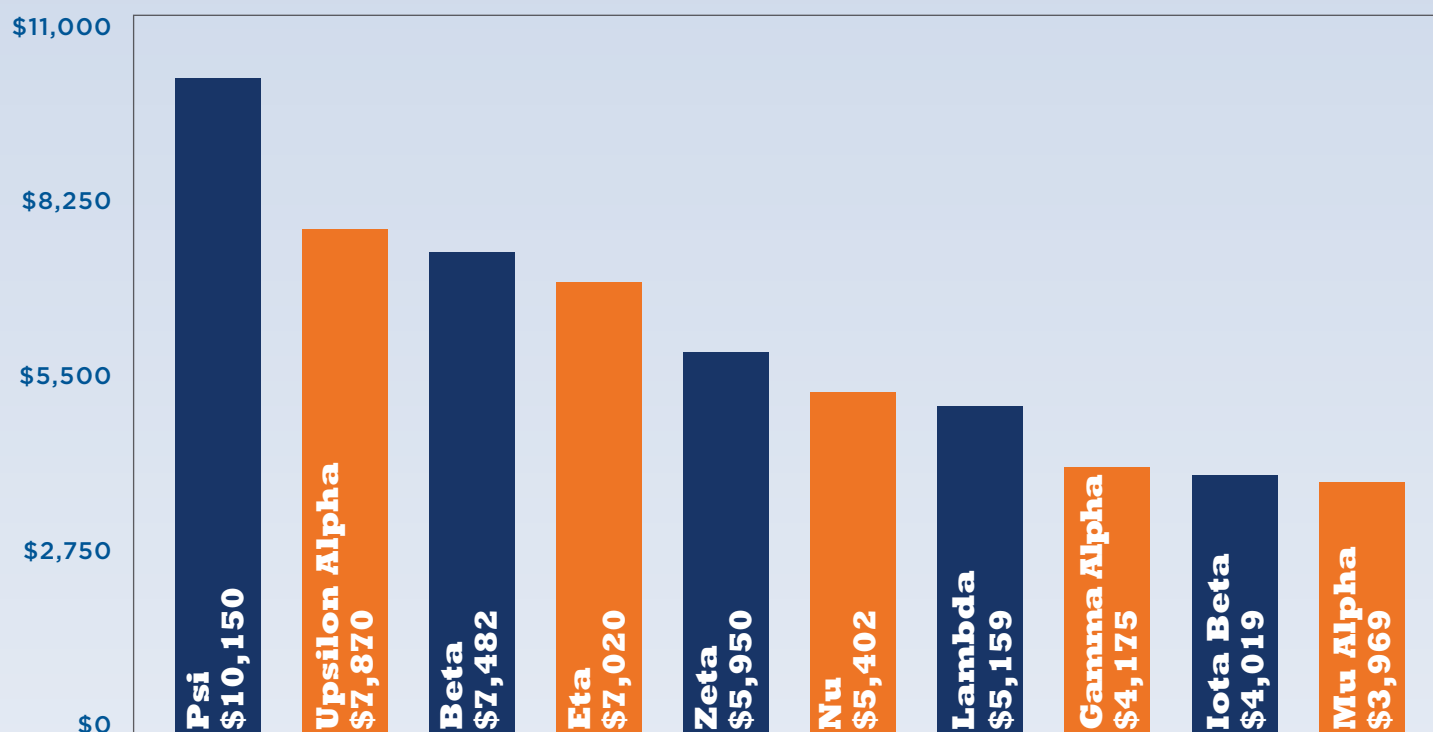

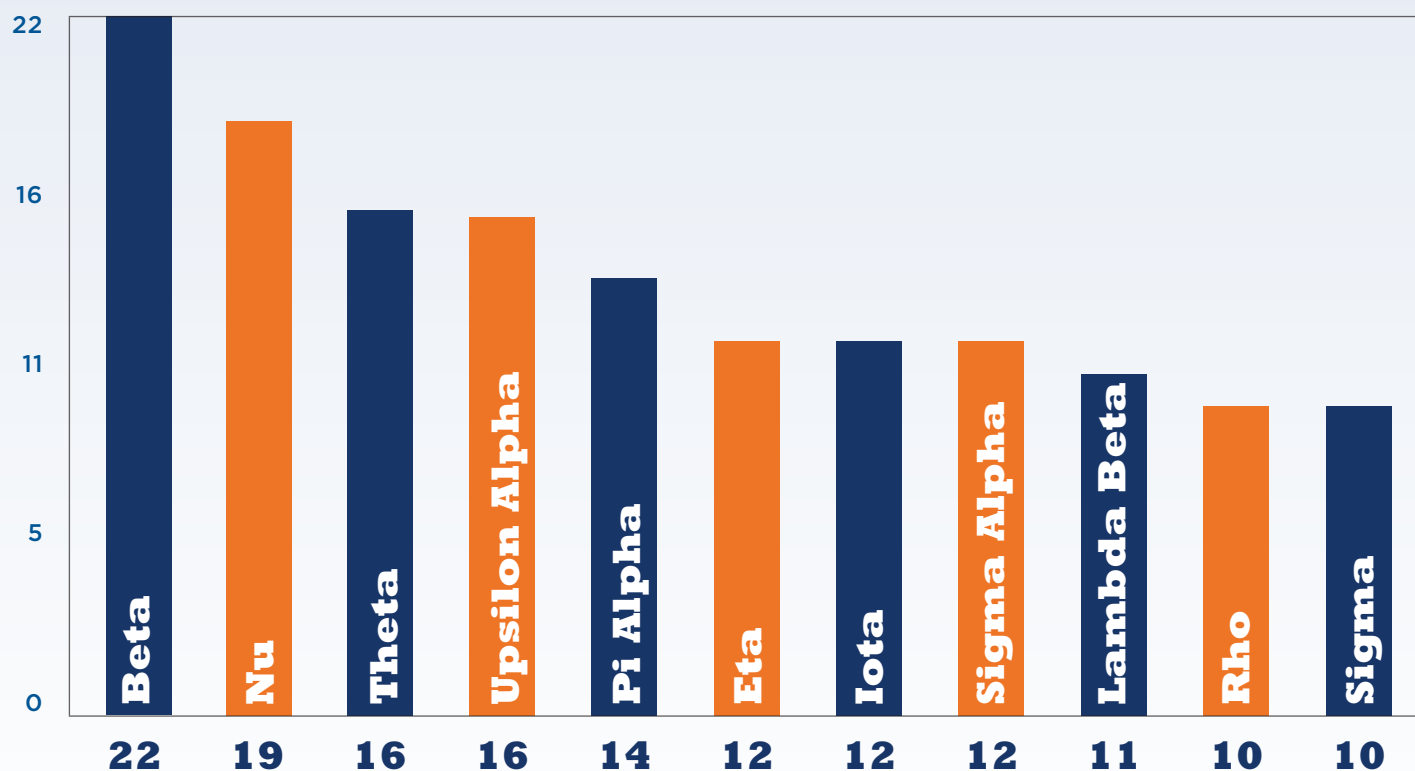

First Charitable Gift Annuity Created

Christopher Harley, Lambda '74

Kappa Delta Rho is blessed to receive financial support from numerous generous Alumni every year. To ensure the continued prosperity of our Fraternity, many Brothers have initiated plans to continue their positive impact on KDR, even after entering Chapter Eternal, by joining the Heritage Society and including KDR in their estate plans. Many Alumni have included Kappa Delta Rho in their wills, while others have named KDR as the beneficiary in a life insurance policy. In some cases, the funds are directed towards KDR's leadership programming. In other cases, the Brother has chosen to endow a scholarship to pay it forward for future Brothers.

Recently, the Foundation partnered with **Chris Harley, Lambda '74** on a first-for-KDR Charitable Gift Annuity (CGA) to enhance the Lambda Chapter Scholarship Fund. As this is a new method of planned giving, we asked Brother Harley to describe how he approached working with the Foundation to satisfy his goals.

WHY DID YOU CHOOSE TO SUPPORT THE LAMBDA SCHOLARSHIP AT THIS TIME?

There were several catalysts for creating the CGA with funds from my IRA at this time:

1. Recent tax legislation includes a number of changes that enhance the ability to make charitable contributions using an IRA.
2. I turned 73 in 2025, which means that I am starting to take Required Minimum Distributions (RMD).
3. With Lambda Chapter being reinstated, a Lambda Chapter Scholarship was created as part of the KDR Foundation, largely due to the efforts of **Monroe McBride, Lambda '76** and the Foundation Board.
4. We have already begun contributing to that fund.

WHY DID YOU CHOOSE TO PROVIDE SUPPORT THROUGH A CGA?

In discussing plans with our accountant, a CGA was one of the tools we explored for tax-efficient giving.

1. The particular program can be used during one tax year by a taxpayer who is making RMDs: essentially anyone who is 73 or older.
2. An amount of up to \$54,000 (inflation-indexed) can be made directly to a qualified charity from the IRA

3. In the case of KDR Foundation, the annuity is administered by the National Gift Annuity Foundation
4. The paperwork and documentation involved were minimal and easy to complete, a few hours; more time-consuming is going about the giving decision itself.
5. The amount donated counts toward the RMD and is subtracted from AGI for 2025. AGI drives a lot of tax issues due to the phasing out of tax benefits that are calculated using AGI.
6. A set life annuity payment is made annually.

WHY DID YOU CHOOSE TO PARTNER WITH THE FOUNDATION ON THE CGA?

In our case, the choice of using the Lambda Scholarship Fund and/or KDR Foundation included:

1. The scholarship fund has already been created and now needs to build an endowment so that annual scholarships can be awarded.
2. I had met new Members and have been acquainted with younger Alumni who worked to get Lambda reinstated.
3. Having received much from my years as a U Cal undergraduate living on Channing Way for four years, I see this as a chance to give back and start building a meaningful pool of funds to attract undergraduates over the long term.
4. In addition, I have lived in a number of countries (Brazil, Guatemala, Honduras, Mexico) and worked with people from around the world (Asia, Africa, Latin America), and US fraternities are fairly unique in giving young men a chance to self-govern, work together, and resolve problems.
5. I think a well-run scholarship fund can reward those students who contribute to running the house, maintain a strong level of academic achievement, participate in university organizations outside the house, and participate in community-wide philanthropic programs.
6. We are a relatively small house so our (all Alumni) giving goes a long way towards carving out a unique niche on the UC campus.

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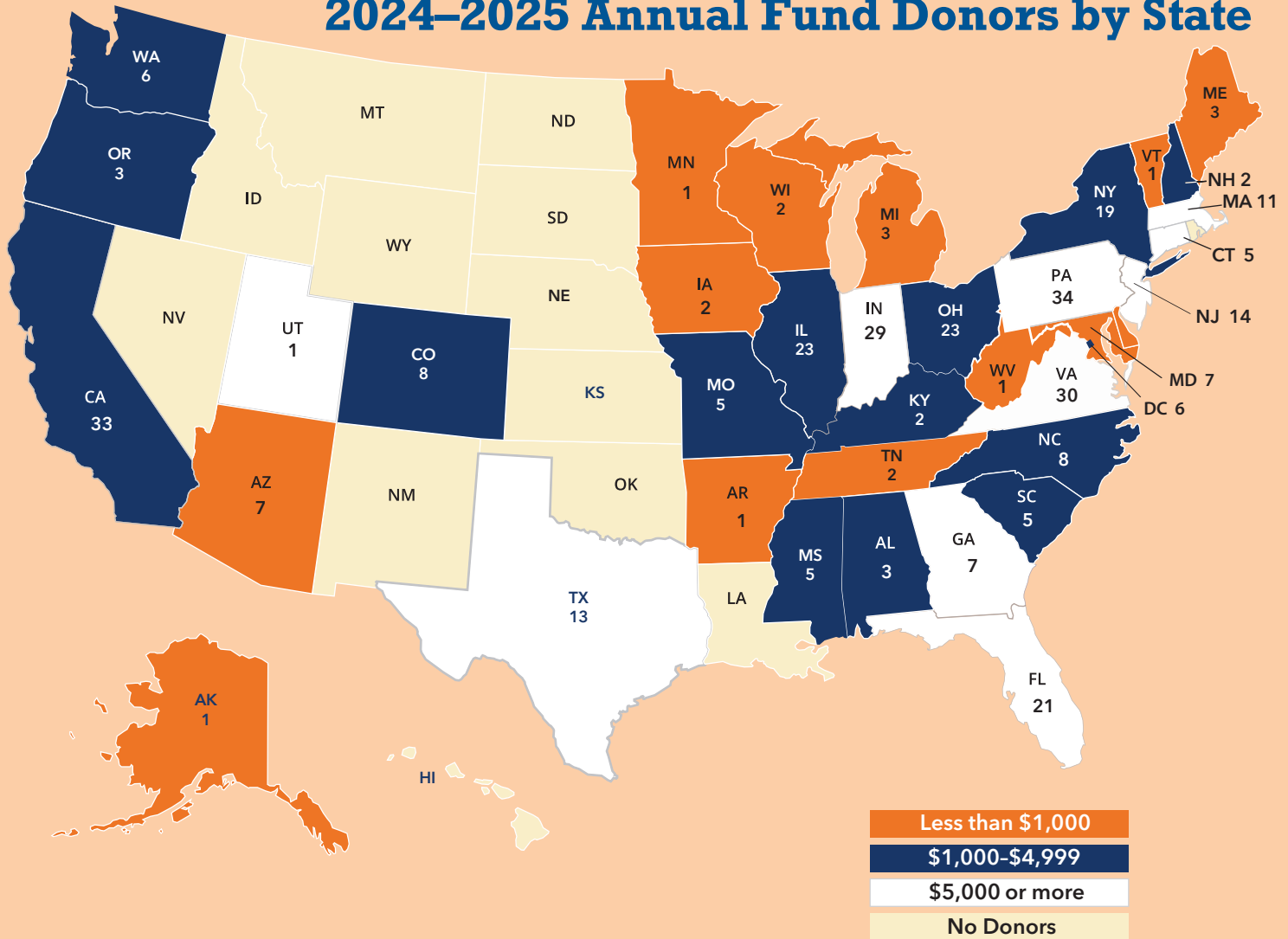
